Through discipleship, church partnerships, internships, empowerment initiatives, education, and strategic communication efforts, thousands were reached with both the Gospel and practical support. Together, these efforts led to transformed lives, stronger communities, and the continued raising of disciples who are grounded in faith and growing in purpose.

# Discipleship Department

In the first quarter, we reached over 6,000 people through ministry programs across 11 schools, 16 churches, a prison, and villages in Kenya. Among them, 135 made the decision to follow Jesus. Our programs are intentionally designed to foster spiritual growth, restore dignity, and strengthen livelihoods. Through these initiatives, women, youth, and families were supported, contributing to holistic transformation across the communities we serve.

# PIPES Internship Program

One of our most impactful initiatives is the Internship Program, made up of five graduates and a dedicated team leader. Together, they lead consistent outreach in schools, churches, and villages—mentoring students in small groups and one-on-one. Through this, they guide young people toward spiritual growth, strong character, leadership development, academic excellence, and a life of purpose.

# School Ministry



In Kenya, school ministry remained a powerful and strategic platform for discipleship, providing consistent access to shape and nurture the next generation. Through structured programs in multiple schools, students were actively engaged in biblical teaching, mentorship, and character formation. These moments are not just lessons—they are life-shaping encounters, helping young people understand God's Word, apply it in their daily lives, and grow into confident, grounded disciples.

- Over 6,000 + students reached through school ministry programs
- 11 schools actively engaged in discipleship and outreach weekly activities
- Pastor Kevin and Nick ministered in schools in Kenya where PIPES is doing outreaches.

# Prison Outreach Ministry

Prison ministry provided a meaningful opportunity to reach young inmates with the Gospel, bringing hope and transformation. Through teaching, interaction, and ongoing support, lives are changing and hearts opening to new beginnings. The PIPES team continues to disciple dozens of inmates at Kamiti, addressing real struggles—including the need for forgiveness. The team also facilitated guided visits, allowing students to experience this ministry firsthand.

## Advancing the Gospel Across Pakistan



PIPES continues to support the work in Pakistan through the Unity in Christ Churches. This quarter, our teams have held multiple crusades drawing thousands, creating opportunities for many to encounter Christ. We rejoice to share that 100 individuals publicly declared their faith through baptism—a powerful testimony of lives transformed and the Gospel advancing. Beyond these gatherings, the team is also leading consistent Bible studies through the PIPES International Discipleship Pathway, equipping new believers to grow in their faith, deepen their understanding of Scripture, and walk confidently as committed disciples of Christ.

# School support: DR Congo

Despite years of hardship in DR Congo, PIPES continues to faithfully serve thousands of vulnerable children in Goma and Idjwi Island. Through the generosity of our partners, children receive education, medical care, and daily meals, while families are strengthened through support to farmers and small businesses. Together, we are bringing light, restoring dignity, and building lasting hope.



PIPES currently support over 1,300 in DR Congo. We've built two schools; One near Goma city and the other in Idjwi Island.

# Feeding Program: Idjwi Island, DR Congo

The feeding program in Congo provides nutritious meals that improve health, boost school attendance, and enhance concentration. It also powerfully demonstrates Christ's love, restoring hope to children and their families. In our Christ-Centered school, students learn the Bible and prayer.

# Ex-High School Candidate Mentorship Program

The Ex-Candidates 2026 pilot program reached 16 grade 12 leavers, equipping them with essential life, career, and mental health skills, alongside practical training in soap making and basic computer skills.



The program had a strong positive impact, helping participants build confidence and better prepare for life after high school. Many participants recommended that the program be conducted regularly and expressed a desire for more advanced computer training when ICT hub is commissioned at LWTC.

# 2,500 + Bibles Distributed in Schools

On March 23, 2026, PIPES partnered with Gideons International, Kajiado Chapter, to distribute a total of 2,569 Bibles across six schools and one hotel in Namanga. This outreach created a powerful opportunity for students and individuals to receive the Word of God and begin a personal journey of faith.

# Adult Literacy Program

New Initiative: Adult literacy program at PIPES International - LWTC

Our Adult Literacy class brings together 13 women with a shared desire to grow in knowledge and faith. The program is designed to equip them with reading skills so they can read and understand the Bible for themselves. As they learn, their confidence is growing, and they are discovering the joy of engaging with God's Word personally.



# Child Sponsorship Program

Through child sponsorship, PIPES provides vulnerable children with education and meals. Sponsors invest in a child's future, helping break cycles of poverty while nurturing Christian faith, leadership, and hope. Together, we are raising a generation equipped to transform their communities.

# Education and Marketing Department

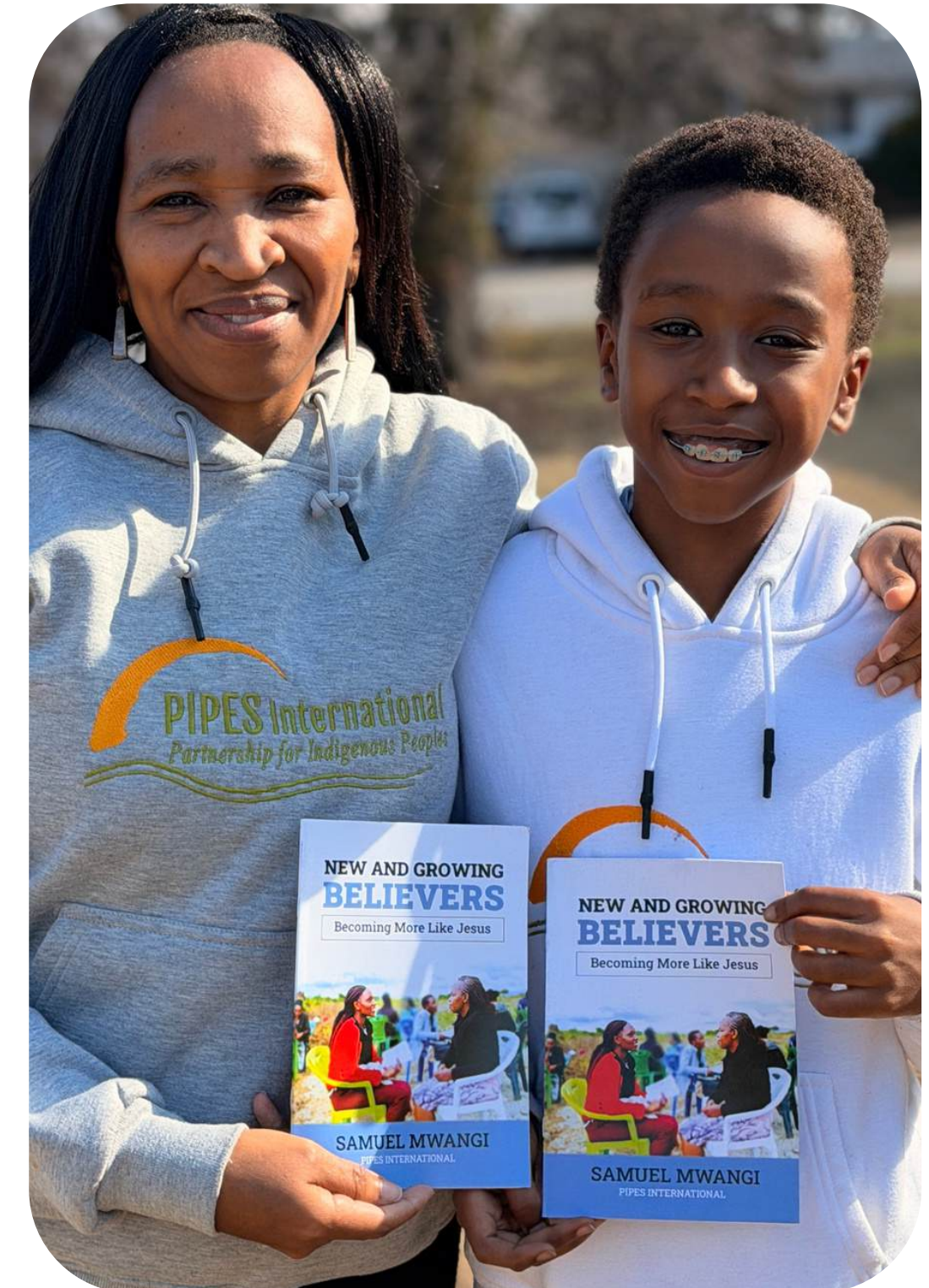

These efforts are not only strengthening school-based discipleship but also deepening students' understanding of Scripture and fostering meaningful spiritual growth, while positioning the LWTC as a hub for learning, leadership, and transformation.

# Girls Empowerment and Hygiene Program

Girls Empowerment Program is committed to transforming lives through holistic programs that address both practical needs and spiritual formation. By equipping girls in schools with skills, knowledge, and providing hygiene products, we restore dignity and build sustainable livelihoods. This initiative has given girls an opportunity to attend school regularly, compete with boys in opportunities, and have dignity and confident. PIPES partners with Worldserve Kenya to provide over 800 girls with menstrual hygiene products every month.



# From Chicken Coops to Vegetables Gardens

## Construction of a Chicken Coop

A secure, well-designed chicken coop was constructed for Jacob, a young beneficiary managing over 40 chickens. This upgrade has improved the safety of the chickens, simplified daily management, and strengthened the long-term sustainability of his poultry project—providing a more reliable and growing source of income.

## Sewing School Graduation in Burundi

We celebrate the graduation of our sewing school trainees in Burundi. Equipped with practical sewing skills, these women are now able to support their families and build sustainable futures. This achievement reflects true empowerment, restored dignity, and hope in action. We are deeply grateful to our partners for supporting PIPES' global work, impacting thousands in some of the most underserved regions, and to BCOM for faithfully implementing this life-changing program.



# Empowerment: Rwanda & DR Congo

Through a PIPES-supported sewing school in Rwanda, dozens of widows and single mothers are rising from poverty to dignity. Through prayer, training, and discipleship, they are gaining practical skills, starting businesses, securing employment, and building hopeful, faith-filled futures for their children.

This impact extends beyond Rwanda. PIPES operates sewing schools in Burundi, Rwanda, and Pakistan, where more than 100 women have graduated—each one a story of restored dignity, strengthened families, and transformed lives.

# Digital Ministry

Through WhatsApp and other digital platforms, over 500 participants are actively engaged in Bible studies, including the New Testament plan and New and Growing Believers. Groups meet weekly for fellowship, prayer, and Scripture reading, demonstrating strong commitment and steady growth. Their consistency and active participation reflect a vibrant community marked by accountability, shared purpose, and a deepening journey of spiritual growth and encouragement. Occasionally, groups meet physically for fun and fellowship.



# The Chapel

The Chapel—a center for worship, prayer, and transformation for generations. Groups meet at the center for retreat, conferences, meetings and prayers.



The chapel will serve as a central space where interns can carry out their programs, including youth conferences, VBS programs, and weekly youth and prayer meetings.



The Chapel will host:

- Men's prayer on Tuesday evenings
- Youth fellowship on Sunday afternoons
- Kingdom Kids Fellowship every Saturday morning
- Women's Bible study

# Upcoming Global Youth Center (Thika-Kenya)

The Upcoming Global Youth Center will be a Christ-centered hub for discipleship, leadership, and empowerment, integrating ICT training to equip young people with essential digital skills. Through mentorship, innovation, and access to technology, youth will be prepared for employment, entrepreneurship, and service. It will provide opportunities for Christian youth to grow spiritually, develop practically, and impact their communities.

# RISING FROM OPPORTUNITY: The Inspiring Story of Saris

One inspiring testimony is Saris, a young Maasai girl whose journey reflects the transforming power of opportunity and discipleship. She first came to the Living Water Transformation Center (LWTC) as a volunteer, assisting in the adult literacy program. What began as simple support grew into facilitating lessons for adults learning to read Scripture for the first time.

This small act of service became a pathway to leadership. In January 2026, Saris joined the PIPES Internship Cohort-2026, where she continues to grow and serve. Today, she shares Christ, mentors girls, and empowers women and youth with skills, confidence, and hope.
