# OVERVIEW



In 2024, PIPES International built on more than 12 years of ministry to achieve measurable and scalable impact through its holistic focus on Discipleship, Education, and Empowerment. Serving indigenous and vulnerable communities, PIPES strengthened outreach, quality, and sustainability while addressing both spiritual transformation and poverty alleviation. A major milestone was launching the Internship Program with five interns serving students and youth in schools, churches, and communities. Another significant achievement was completing a new school on Idjwi Island, DRC, expanding access to education and hope for vulnerable children and families.



# Education Impact in 2024

Education remained one of the most tangible indicators of transformation in 2024. PIPES focused on ensuring consistent access, quality learning environments, and community ownership, particularly in regions where education infrastructure is limited or absent. In March 2024, PIPES opened doors for a new school in Idjwi Island. The school construction began in 2022 and completed in 2024.

# A New School in DR Congo



**A major milestone in 2024 was achieved with the completion of six classrooms and temporary administrative facilities at the Idjwi Island school. By April 2024:**

- Over 300 students were enrolled and are receiving quality education. Local teachers were employed, strengthening livelihoods and accountability.
- The school provided a safe and structured learning environment in a previously underserved area.

**Meanwhile, our first school in eastern Congo continued to serve over 700 students, maintaining strong academic outcomes and reinforcing the long-term value of investing in education as a pathway out of poverty.**

# Child Sponsorships



## **Nkidede: Rising Above Adversity**

Nkidede, a 15-year-old Grade 8 student from a remote village in Namanga, Kenya, has faced immense hardship. Raised by her grandmother after losing her mother at birth, she grew up in deep poverty with limited access to food, education, and other basic needs. She also experienced family loss and hardship, including the early marriage of her sisters and the death of her brother.

At age 13, while in Grade 6, she was raped and became pregnant and faced even greater challenges. Encouraged by her teacher to return to school after giving birth, Nkidede returned to school with determination to pursue her education. After learning of her situation, PIPES enrolled her in its sponsorship program. Today, she is pursuing her academics with determination. She dreams of becoming a nurse, to care for her grandmother and son, and helping girls in her community overcome challenges such as early marriage and teenage pregnancy.



## **Joshua: A Dream Worth Walking For**

Joshua is a 15-year-old Grade 9 student and the only son among seven siblings. In 2023, he achieved the highest score in his school on Kenya's Grade 8 national examination, demonstrating exceptional academic ability, discipline, and determination. His outstanding performance earned him admission to a highly regarded high school. However, due to a lack of school fees and essential supplies, he was unable to enroll and instead joined a local underperforming day school, walking approximately 14 miles each day to attend classes.

PIPES International learned about Joshua's situation through local leaders who sought support on his behalf and enrolled him in our sponsorship program in 2024. Joshua dreams of becoming an ICT engineer so he can support his siblings' education, provide for his parents, and help vulnerable children access educational opportunities.

**Joshua's and Nkidede's stories reflect the reality many vulnerable children face. Although they have dreams and potential, poverty often limits their access to education and opportunity. We are seeking additional child sponsors to provide school fees and educational. Sponsorship gives children more than an education. They give them hope, opportunity, and a pathway toward a transformed future.**

# Empowerment

In 2024, PIPES' empowerment initiatives focused on women, girls, families, smallholder farmers, and disaster-affected households, strengthening livelihoods, promoting economic opportunities, and building long-term resilience through holistic support and sustainable development efforts

Additionally, we equipped 50 women with practical sewing and soap making skills to strengthen income-generating opportunities and promote long-term economic empowerment, as outlined below.

**20 women in Rwanda**  
**10 women in Burundi**  
**20 women in Pakistan**

These women gained practical skills, started small businesses, and contributed to household income. Importantly, the programs also served as platforms for regular gospel engagement, including among women from non-Christian backgrounds.



# Agriculture and Food Security

Farming initiatives supported approximately 250 farmers in 2024 most of them in Burundi and Rwanda, providing training, quality seeds, and basic inputs. In Burundi, families moved from reliance on aid to food security and surplus production, improving nutrition and generating income through crop sales.

## Disaster Response

PIPES continued to integrate compassion into empowerment:

Support included food aid, healthcare access, and recovery assistance in Kenya, Congo, Rwanda, Pakistan, and among Ukraine refugees in Moldova. Specialized interventions restored dignity and productivity among affected families.



# Discipleship Impact in 2024

Discipleship remained the spiritual foundation of PIPES' work in 2024. The organization continued to equip local churches with contextualized, Bible-based discipleship tools, ensuring that transformation was rooted in Scripture and sustained through local leadership. Discipleships grew in Pakistan and East Africa.

# By The End of 2024:



PIPES emphasized church-led disciple-making, empowering pastors and believers to multiply impact within their own communities. Through mission trips, Bible study groups, and local outreaches, the gospel continued to be shared in both open and challenging contexts, with ongoing ministry presence in Kenya, DR Congo, Rwanda, Burundi, Pakistan, and the United States.

Over 10 churches had adopted Study the New Testament in One Year, with rapid momentum toward broader uptake

Discipleship materials were actively used in local languages, improving accessibility and cultural relevance.

Approximately 100 churches were mobilized through training, outreach, and mentoring support.



## PIPES Internship Program

One of the most significant developments in 2024 was the launch of the PIPES Internship Program. This initiative was designed to engage and transform the lives of students and youth through schools, churches, and community-based outreach. Through structured school engagements, the program reached thousands of students by providing discipleship, mentorship, counseling, leadership development, and career guidance, helping young people grow spiritually, personally, and academically.





Interns worked closely with schools, churches, and community leaders to mentor students, support learning, and model positive leadership. Beyond academics, students benefited from guidance in character development, goal setting, and spiritual formation.





## Conclusion

2024 stands as a powerful testimony to what is possible when faith, partnership, and intentional action align. Through discipleship, education, socioeconomic empowerment, and youth engagement, PIPES International achieved not only wider reach, but deeper and more sustainable impact—strengthening churches, expanding access to education, restoring dignity to women, stabilizing families, and guiding young people toward hope and purpose.

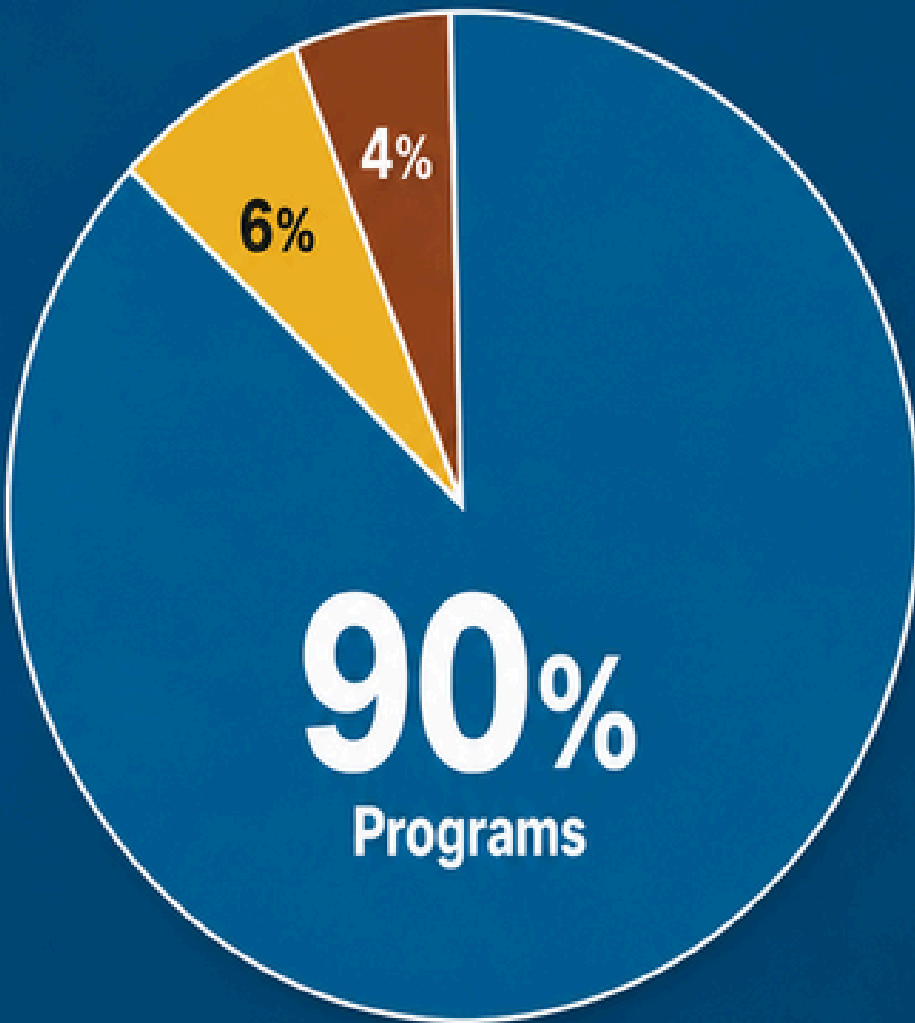

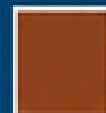
