Executive Summary

During the first half of 2026, PIPES International continued advancing its mission of making disciples and ending poverty through discipleship, quality education, and empowerment initiatives. Serving across six countries through churches, schools, Bible studies, prisons, villages, and digital platforms, we reached over 8,000 people with the Gospel, discipleship, and practical skills. Many responded in faith, with over 160 baptisms in Pakistan and Kenya. We also sponsored vulnerable students and, in partnership with WorldServe, provided menstrual hygiene products to 800 girls in Kenya and 200 in DR Congo, helping restore dignity and support school attendance. Across Africa and Pakistan, women were further empowered through sewing, farming, and other livelihood skills—equipping them to strengthen their families and build more sustainable futures.

DISCIPLESHIP & INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Discipleship & Internship Department–Ministry Overview

During the first half of 2026, PIPES-Kenya expanded its outreach to youth and students in schools and churches, reaching thousands with the Gospel, biblical teaching, mentorship, and discipleship. Through school visits, Challenge Weekends, small groups, and one-on-one mentoring, students are growing in faith, character, leadership, and purpose. Our partnership with Kenya Students Christian Fellowship (KSCF) is opening even greater opportunities across Kenya.

In partnership with **Harvester Christian Church (Missouri)**, PIPES continues to reach thousands of students in schools in Kenya. PIPES has also hosted two teams from HCC this year.



PIPES Internship Program–Kenya

In January, we welcomed four interns, with a fifth joining in April. Guided by a dedicated team leader, these graduates serve in schools, churches, and villages through outreach, mentorship, and discipleship, helping young people deepen their faith, build character, develop leadership skills, and discover their God-given purpose.

Vacation Bible School (VBS)

In April 2026, PIPES International successfully hosted its first-ever Vacation Bible School (VBS), bringing together 150 children for three exciting days of learning, fun, and spiritual growth. In June we held our second VBS with the Harvester Christian Church team.



Prison Outreach Ministry–Kenya

In 2026, PIPES International expanded its discipleship program by incorporating Kamiti Prison Juvenile Department, bringing spiritual guidance, hope, and transformation to young inmates. In May, we hosted 64 correctional staff for leadership training and team building, strengthening relationships and creating opportunities for greater impact within Kenya's prison system.



LIGHT IN ACTION: Advancing the Gospel Across Pakistan



PIPES continues to support ministry in Pakistan through Unity in Christ Churches. During the first half of 2026, the team reached thousands with the Gospel through crusades and outreach, with 150 people publicly declaring their faith through baptism. Through the PIPES International Discipleship Pathway, new believers are growing in Scripture and being equipped to become mature, committed disciples of Christ.

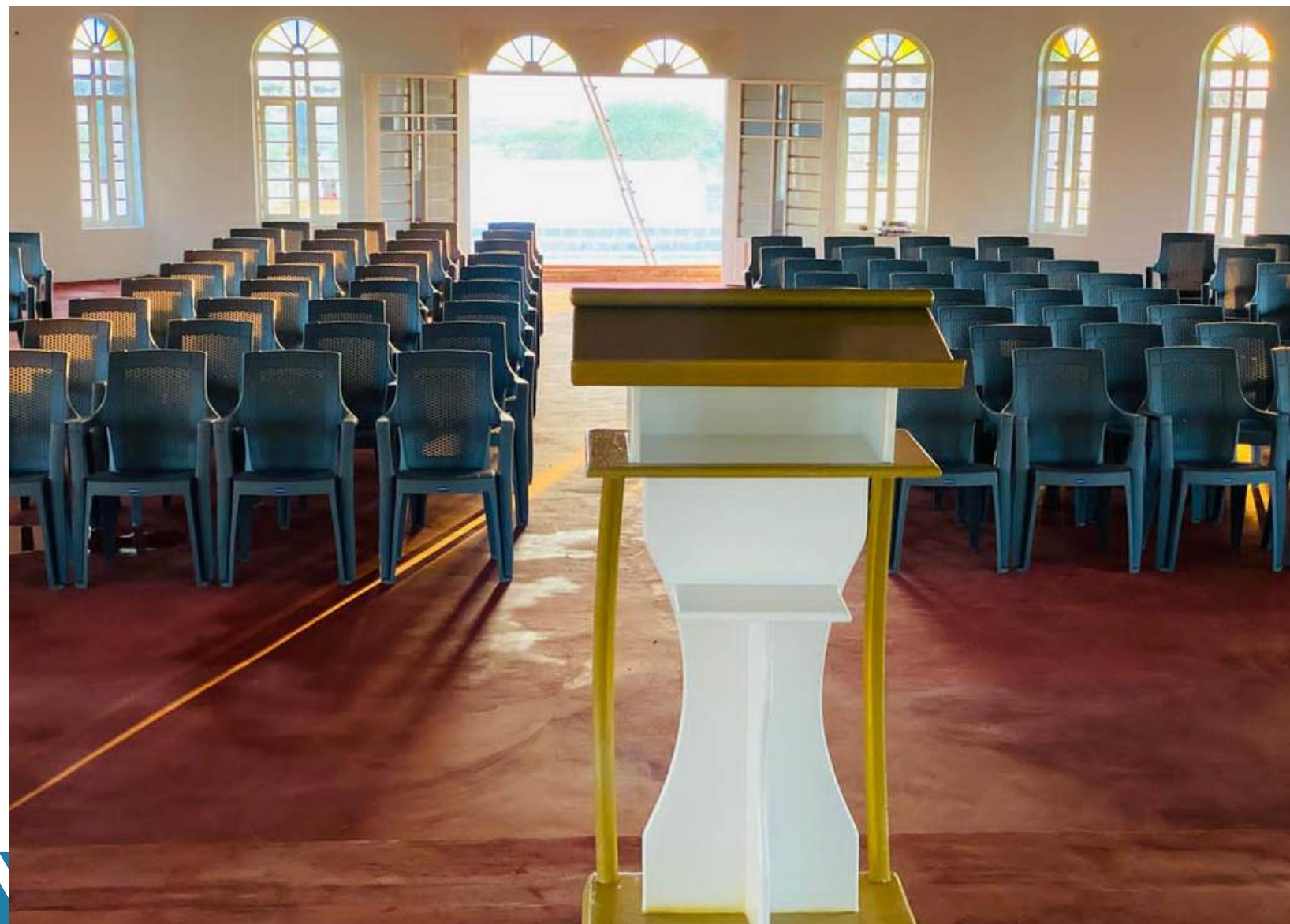
Student Ministry



PIPES staff and interns led weekly Bible studies and mentorship programs in schools, nurturing students' faith, character, leadership, and purpose. During international mission trips, visiting teams also engaged with students and participated in school outreach and ministry activities.

One of the highlights of the June 2026 mission was the dedication of our new chapel, which was immediately followed by VBS and culminated in the baptism of six new believers.



Pastors and Leaders Training



PIPES strengthens local churches through regular training for pastors and leaders and distributes discipleship materials translated into local languages for use in PIPES ministry countries and beyond.

Digital Ministry

Through WhatsApp and digital platforms, over 500 participants were actively engaged in Bible studies, including the New Testament study and New and Growing Believers. Groups meet weekly for online fellowship, prayer, and Scripture reading. Occasionally, groups meet physically for fun and fellowship.

EDUCATION

Access to quality education : DR Congo

Despite years of hardship in DR Congo, PIPES faithfully serves vulnerable children and families in Goma and Idjwi Island. Through our partners' generosity, children receive education, medical care, and nutritious meals, while families are empowered through farming and small businesses—restoring dignity, strengthening communities, and building lasting hope.



PIPES currently supports over 1,300 in DR Congo access quality education and meals. We've built two schools; One in Mugunga, near Goma city and another on Idjwi Island.

Feeding Program: Idjwi Island, DR Congo

Congo's feeding program provides nutritious meals that improve children's health, attendance, and learning while demonstrating Christ's love.

In our Christ-centered schools, students receive quality education, biblical teaching, and prayer, nurturing faith, character, and hope for a brighter future.

A visit to Autism School International



One of the schools we love visiting serves 110 children with autism. Spending time, playing, and interacting with the children creates meaningful moments of joy, connection, and encouragement for both the children and our visiting teams. PIPES also sponsors two students in this school.

2,500 + Bibles Distributed in Schools

On March 23, 2026, PIPES partnered with Gideons International, to distribute 2,569 Bibles across six schools. This outreach created a powerful opportunity for students and individuals to receive the Word of God and begin a personal journey of faith.

Through regular home visits, our staff identify vulnerable families, understand their immediate needs, and provide practical support, including groceries, food, and other essential items demonstrating God's love in action.

Threads of Hope

Sewing School Graduation in Burundi

In March, we celebrated our sewing school graduates in Burundi. Equipped with practical skills, these women can now support their families and build sustainable futures. We are grateful to our partners and **BCOM** for making this life-changing program possible—restoring dignity, creating opportunity, and bringing lasting hope.



Empowering Women Through Sewing Skills in Rwanda

Through PIPES-supported sewing school in Kigali, Rwanda, widows and single mothers are rising from poverty to dignity. Through prayer, discipleship, and vocational training, women gain skills, employment, and opportunities to start businesses. In two years, over 100 women have graduated across Rwanda, Burundi, and Pakistan.



Adult Literacy Program at LWTC

Our Adult Literacy Class brings together women with a shared desire to grow in knowledge, confidence, and faith. The program equips them with essential reading, writing, and basic numeracy skills, enabling them to read and understand the Bible for themselves, manage simple household budgets, and make informed decisions in their daily lives.



From Beads to Better Future



Our Women's Empowerment Program equips women with skills to improve their beadwork and helps market their products, enabling them to support their families and build sustainable livelihoods.

Her Dignity, Her Future

Our Girls' Empowerment Program equips girls with knowledge, life skills, and menstrual hygiene products, restoring dignity, confidence, and school attendance. In partnership with WorldServe Kenya, PIPES provides hygiene products to over 800 girls each month in Kenya.

We are also supporting 200 girls in Congo bringing to a total of 1,000 girls impacted by this program.

A girl's period should never stand between her and her education. We empower girls with the dignity, confidence, and resources they need to stay in school and thrive.

Grade 12 graduates Mentorship Program

PIPES launched a pilot program for 16 Form 4 graduates, equipping them with essential life skills, basic computer skills, career guidance, emotional well-being, and practical soap-making skills. We plan to begin computer skills training in the second half of the year.

Upcoming Global Youth Center (Thika-Kenya)

The Global Youth Center, currently under construction, will be a Christ-centered hub for discipleship, leadership, and empowerment. Through ICT training, mentorship, and spiritual formation, young people will gain digital and life skills, preparing them for employment and entrepreneurship and equipping them to positively impact their families, communities, and cities.

A Life Transformed: Saitoti's Journey of Faith and Hope



At the LWTC Retreat and Prayer grounds, our worker - Saitoti, experienced the transforming love of Christ through a PIPES staff who shared the message of salvation with him. Moved by God's Word, he joyfully said "YES" to Jesus and surrendered his life to Him.

Early this year, Saitoti got baptized at our baptistry. Saitoti's heart has been renewed and his purpose awakened. He now walks in the light of God's truth and actively participates in our Lunch-Hour services at the LWTC center, radiating the peace and joy of his newfound faith. He is now a witness of Jesus to his friends and family.



From Opportunity to Purpose: The Inspiring Story of Saris



Saris, a young Maasai girl, first came to the Living Water Transformation Center as a volunteer in the adult literacy program, helping adults learn to read Scripture for the first time. Her service became a pathway to leadership, and in January 2026, she joined the PIPES Internship Cohort–2026.

Today, Saris shares Christ, mentors girls, and empowers women and youth with skills, confidence, and hope. Your partnership makes stories like hers possible—raising young leaders who transform their communities for generations.
