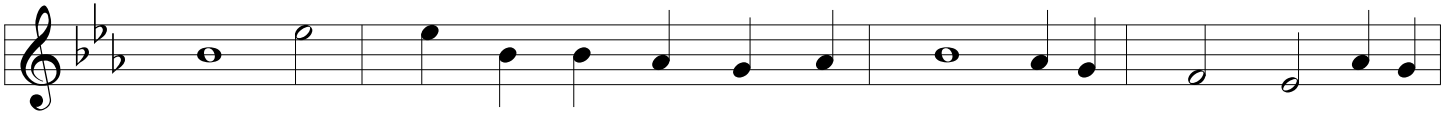

Passport Kids Camp, July 19-22

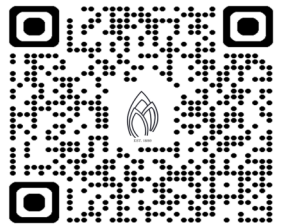
