The Liberation of Your Freedom

Lesson 9

Tonight I have come to open the gate to freedom.... Release the beast in you... the best in you..... the boldness in you... the breath of God in you.. the breakthrough power in you!!!!

Peter was thrown in Prison because of the power of his witness.. Acts 12

The Road To Freedom: John 8:36 NLT ...So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free.

- Suffering for righteousness sake is suffering because you have been justified from, all of your sins.
- Our sins aren't justified, we are; our sins have been crucified in Christ and through Christ on the cross.
- Live beyond your sins and your deliverance will become authentic.
- When you sin, confess them to the Lord!! We are made free by the truth we know and believe about Christ at salvation.
- We are set free when we choose to walk through the gates of sin that keeps us bound to that which we have been made free.

John 8:31-32 ESV

31 “So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples,

32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.””

Matthew 5:13-16 ESV

13 ““You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people’s feet.

14 “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.

15 Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house.

16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.””

19 “Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus,

20 by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh,

21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God,

22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the

habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

- **The Assignment of The Saints: To walk in a whole new dimension of Christian Allegiance, Authority, Demonic Attack and Apostolic and Prophetic Victory!!**

The WILD LIFE Principle:

1. Willing to Inspire and Impart- Take the light that you possess and impact others with it.

2. Impartially Inviting- Move past any racial indifferences and discrimination and engage others to hear and respond to the message of Christ.

3. Loving and Loyal- Your old nature or any other part of you that does not project your love and loyalty to Christ, you must make that your prisoner.

- In the local church assembly where you serve and fellowship, you must display and develop a discipline that governs undisciplined behavior patterns.

4. Devoted, Disciplined and Dangerous- Every spiritual fear you have you've got to abandon them, so that you will be able to be a wrecking ball believer to the kingdom of darkness.

Part 1: Biblical Outline for a Spiritual Ground Game

I. Spiritual Intelligence: Understanding the Battlefield

- Ephesians 6:12 – 'For we wrestle not against flesh and blood...'
- 2 Corinthians 2:11 – 'Lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.'
- Key Principle: Discern the spiritual landscape. Every territory has strongholds, influences, and patterns. Effective ground game begins with spiritual insight.

II. Prayer as Ground Preparation

- 2 Chronicles 7:14 – 'If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray...'
- Luke 18:1 – 'Men ought always to pray and not faint.'
- Key Principle: Prayer prepares the soil. A consistent, targeted prayer strategy breaks up spiritual resistance.

III. Evangelism & Discipleship as Ground Advancement

- Matthew 28:19-20 – 'Go and make disciples of all nations...'
- Romans 10:14 – 'How shall they hear without a preacher?'
- Key Principle: Personal witnessing, street ministry, and follow-up discipleship create lasting spiritual impact.

IV. Acts of Service as Kingdom Footprints

- Matthew 5:16 – 'Let your light so shine before men...'

- James 2:17 – 'Faith by itself, if it has no works, is dead.'
- Key Principle: Serving others demonstrates God's love and establishes a visible Kingdom presence.

V. Persistence & Presence

- Galatians 6:9 – 'Do not grow weary in well doing...'
- Joshua 1:3 – 'Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you...'
- **Key Principle: "Consistency beats intensity."** The enemy retreats where God's people maintain spiritual pressure.

Part 2: Practical Strategy for a Spiritual Ground Game

Phase 1: Prepare the Ground

- Conduct spiritual mapping. Identify local strongholds (violence, addiction, poverty, etc.)
- Assemble a prayer team. Begin intercessory prayer walks in target areas.
- Fast corporately. Focus on getting breakthrough's in specific strongholds.

***I am asking that we do an all day liquid fast every Monday hereafter, until after the graduation. We will have a reception afterwards for the graduates.**

Phase 2: Engage the Ground

- Launch community outreach (**e.g., food drives, clothing giveaways, cleanup crews**).
- Share the Gospel personally. Train teams for one-on-one evangelism. **(The 144 Principle)**
- Hold outdoor prayer or worship nights. Shift the spiritual atmosphere. **(Camp Fire Crusades)**

Phase 3: Build on the Ground

- Start home/small group Bible studies. Create discipleship pods in key neighborhoods.
- Partner with local schools, nonprofits, shelters. Be a consistent presence.
- Train new leaders. Multiply teams who can reproduce this model.

Phase 4: Establish a Kingdom Culture

- Host revival gatherings or citywide prayer rallies.
- Speak into city issues with godly wisdom.
- Raise up Kingdom influencers. Encourage believers to lead in schools, politics, and business.
