Main Idea: We should feel compelled to herald the King.

Applying the Truth Personally

- The *event* of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem is the main focus of our text. What impact does Jesus's Triumphal Entry have on me?

- What can I do this week to increase my compulsion to herald my King?

Applying the Truth Congregationally

- How does the fact that Jesus' actions create "peace in heaven" (v. 38) rather than "peace on earth" impact the mission of our church?

- What impact(s) should Jesus' answer in verse 40 have on our church's actions?
