

Sound and Light Equipment Use Policy

The equipment that is used to carry out the ministry and mission of the Sound and Light Committee is technical and awfully expensive. As the church continues to grow, investment in this type equipment will also grow.

In order to be good stewards of this investment, and due to the technical nature of the duties, the church stipulates that no one other than those persons specifically authorized by the Sound and Light Committee of Aversboro Road Baptist Church shall operate or re-configure any sound and light equipment owned by the church.

Under no circumstances will any visiting artist or performer nor any of their staff be granted access to the sound and light equipment rack located in the left organ tower.

Under the direct supervision of and accompanied by a Sound and Light Committee member, a visiting performer may connect their own equipment to the board and make temporary cabling changes only as necessary for their program, provided that the board be returned to its original configuration immediately following the program.
