

Trustees**Aversboro Road Baptist Church Mission Statement:**

To proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ and to minister to the needs of our Congregation, the Community, and the World, through the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

General Purpose of the Position:

To execute contracts, deeds, mortgages, or other instruments when authorized to do so by the church in conference.

Membership:

The church shall annually elect one member to serve as a trustee whose term of office shall be for three years. A trustee shall be eligible for re-election. Upon the death, resignation, or inability to serve of any of the trustees a successor shall be elected by the church in conference. It is important that a trustee position be filled immediately upon a vacancy occurring.

Duties:

1. The trustees shall assemble as required for the purpose of executing all contracts, mortgages, deeds, or other instruments requiring execution on behalf of the church when authorized to do so by the church in conference.
2. All documents, deeds, etc., are to be executed by the trustees.
3. All documents or instruments requiring execution by the trustees should be directed to the Lead Pastor, or in the Lead Pastor's absence, the Chairman of Deacon's, who shall be responsible for assembling the trustees for document execution.
