

Recreation Committee

Scope: Administer a church sponsored recreation program.

Purpose:

To administer church sponsored recreation programs. To plan recreational activities for church functions.

Membership:

Composed of three members nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the church for three-year terms which begin in January annually. Ex-officio members of the committee are a Pastoral staff liaison assigned by the Lead Pastor and a Deacon liaison assigned by the Deacon chair.

Relationships:

The committee assists the church, within the realm of the committee purpose, in fulfilling the church's Mission: To proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to minister to the needs of our congregation, the community, and the world through the leadership of the Holy Spirit. This committee shall utilize the five Biblical Functions of Worship, Fellowship, Discipleship, Ministry, and Evangelism in meeting the committee's purpose and duties and in communicating, collaborating, coordinating, and cooperating with others. The Committee Chair serves as a member of the Church Council.

Duties:

1. Submit a committee budget to the Budget and Finance Committee when requested; to include entry fees and supplies for church sponsored teams, recreation equipment for the church, and supplies for church functions.
2. Monitor expenses paid to be sure they are reasonable and fair.
3. Plan recreational activities for church-wide functions and secure necessary equipment. Committee may initiate this action on its own or be notified to do so by the church staff or by other appropriate authority.
4. Plan and administer church-sponsored recreation programs and teams.
5. Meet as often as needed to accomplish the committee's purpose.
6. Invite assigned Pastoral staff and Deacon liaisons to committee meetings and provide a copy of meeting minutes.
