OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOEBOXES: Join Joy at 10AM on Thursday, **September 29th to help set up** fellowship hall for the "packing party".

Our goal this year is to pack 240 *quality* filled shoeboxes following the second service **on October 2.** Imagine the joy on a child's face when they open their shoebox filled with an amazing assortment of toys. May a child feel Jesus' love in our shoeboxes.





Let's help our neighbors in Kentucky. Following the devastating flooding throughout Kentucky, UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) is in need of Cleaning Kits. Please consider donating one or two items from the following list. A more detailed list of additional items needed is on the Action Table. Collection bin available in the gathering area.

Last day to donate these items is Sunday, October 2nd.

- One 16-34 oz. bottle dish soap
- Five scouring pads (no stainless-steel pads with soap in them).
- 36-50 clothespins
- One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)
- 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45-gallon sizes)
- Two pairs kitchen gloves (durable for multiple uses)
- One pair work gloves (cotton with leather palm or all leather)
- One scrub brush (with or without handle)

Packaging will be removed at time of placement in the bucket.

SOCKS FOR THE HOMELESS: It's never too early to start looking for crew socks for men, women and children. Collecting in October provides time to get the socks to those in need before the weather turns cold. Our socks will be donated to the Methodist Church on the North Side. Collection bin available in the gathering area.
