



# Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy

## Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct & Commitment

I/we, as parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that God has called me/us as a parent to instruct my/our child in the faith. I/we am/are the one(s) primarily responsible for my/our child's Christian education, but I/we request that Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy further assists me/us in honoring my/our commitments as a parent. I/we also give testimony that I/we am/are a Christian disciple and am/are called to bear witness to God's word in Jesus Christ. I/we agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct & Commitments:

### PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I/we will accept and act in accordance with the school's Statement of Faith, Philosophy, and Objectives, and I am committed to upholding them.
2. I/we agree to try at all times to manifest by daily example the highest Christian virtue serving as a Christian role model (1 Timothy 4:12) both in and out of my/our home, but in particular while I/we am/are on school property or attending school events.
3. I/we agree that learning is not only through receiving and interpreting rational explanations of formal subject material, but even more powerfully through word, deed, example, and shared experience. While on school grounds and while attending school or church events or activities, I/we agree to bear witness to the principles taught at Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy by being a role model in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. I/we acknowledge that this includes, but is not limited to, the refraining from such activities as intemperate use of alcohol (being drunk), use of tobacco or other smoking products, use of illicit drugs, and the use of vulgar and profane language.
4. I/we agree that God has a plan for me and my child, and that sexuality is a gift from God as clearly defined in Scripture. (Romans 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8; 1 Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 2:19-22; 1 Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; 1 John 3:1-3). While on school grounds and while attending school or church events or activities, I/we agree to conduct myself according to biblical principles at all times. This means that I/we will refrain from any sexual misconduct, including, but not limited to, premarital sex, extramarital affairs, homosexual activity, sexual harassment, use or viewing of pornographic material or websites, sexual abuse of children, and other forms of sexually deviant behavior. I/we understand that such public behaviors or deviations from Scripture are grounds for my child's expulsion.

I/we also agree that the unique roles of the male and female are clearly defined in Scripture, and that Romans 1:24-32 condemns the homosexual lifestyle (Romans 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8; 1 Timothy 4:12; 2 Timothy 2:19-22; 1 Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; 1 John 3:1-3). Accordingly, I/we agree that I/we will not engage in any homosexual behavior or publicly support homosexuality.

6. I/we agree to try at all times to understand, appreciate, love, and serve my fellow brothers and sisters in the community, my/our friends, and family members, and will to the best of my/our ability encourage my/our own and their own spiritual, intellectual, physical, and emotional development, through regular prayer, Scripture study and memorization, fellowship, and discernment of God's gifts.
7. I/we agree to conduct myself on campus and at school-sponsored or school-related events, in a manner worthy of the calling I/we have received. This includes maintaining a modest appearance, engaging in regular prayer, refraining from all forms of violence and hatred, including bullying, trash talk, hazing, profanity, and vandalism.
8. I/we agree to follow the biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 for conflict resolution. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing biblical principles.

### PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT

1. I/we agree to faithfully attend and financially support a local church whose fundamental beliefs are in agreement with the Statement of Faith of this school. (Hebrews 10:25)
2. I/we accept the challenge to "train up a child in the way he should go" (Proverbs 22:6), and we do state that this training occurs in the home. I/we place our trust in Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy to extend that training more completely.

3. I/we do hereby state that I/we have made an investigation of the school's program, curriculum, discipline, dress code, etc., and I/we agree to make them our choice for the coming school year.
4. I/we will faithfully support the school through our prayers and positive attitude, and in keeping with Matthew 18:15, I/we are committed to share any complaints and negative comments only with the people involved, and agree that social media and the internet is not an appropriate place to address concerns or complaints about leadership, students, or parents. Unresolved issues will be taken to the Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy leadership, then to the pastor over the ministry.
5. I/we understand that the standard of Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy does not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonoring the Word of God, disrespect to the personnel of the school, or continued disobedience to the established policies of the school.
6. I/we believe that discipline is necessary for the benefit of each student as well as for the entire school, and I/we give permission to the leadership to make and enforce school regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles. I/we further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in the home as needed.
7. I/we commit to pay for any damages to the school, including broken windows, graffiti, and abuse of other personal property caused or created by my child.
8. I/we, as parent(s)/guardian(s) will support the school by making my/our best efforts to be present and involved in monthly Parent Meetings, fellowship activities, workdays, and other school-sponsored meetings, activities and fundraisers, as appropriate.
9. I/we understand that the school does not provide student medical insurance, and that it is my/our responsibility to provide my/our own.
10. I/we understand that agreeing to and adhering to these commitments and codes of conduct is a condition of my/our child's enrollment, and that any public or publicly known violation of these standards and commitments will be cause for my/our child's immediate expulsion.
11. I/we understand and will fulfill my/our financial commitment to pay for the educational services the school is providing for my/our child. I/we also understand that there are absolutely no refunds on registration fees.
