New Safety Policy

As a result of a recent Safety Meeting, a new policy has been established, effective immediately. Exterior doors of St. John's facilities are to no longer be propped open for any reason, whether it's propped with a door stop, brick, bag, chair, etc. If you have an event or activity that will require multiple people/entries, you are to assign a door monitor to open for each person. This pertains to all exterior doors of St. John's property: gym, preschool, Faith Center, office, etc. for all activities, meetings, ball practices, groups, rehearsals, etc. Security cameras will be monitored daily to reinforce this policy. If you are found propping a door you will no longer be permitted to have use of the building.

St. John's Holy Land Trip – Informational Meeting TONIGHT
