Music Notes

Each Sunday during Lent, with the exception of Palm Sunday, the choir will sing a different setting of the Greek words, "Kyrie eleison. Christe eleison." This translates to "Lord have mercy. Christ have mercy." Why is the choir singing in Greek? These are among the most ancient of words used in Christian worship. When the Mass was said in Latin, these words remained in Greek. When Luther began to celebrate the mass in German, he too retained the Greek. Look at hymns no. 482-484 in our hymnal, published in 1989. You will find that these Greek words were clearly still being used in many Methodist churches. To this day, worldwide, the most widely understood and used words remain "Kyrie eleison. Christe eleison." Since we focus on our sinfulness and God's mercy through Jesus during Lent, it seems fitting to add our voices to those of countless saints who have used and are currently using these words in worship.


