



Read the story of Moses and the Burning Bush in **Exodus 3:1-4:17**



Discussion: Use the following questions to discuss with your family, friends and/or life group.

1. What details in the story stand out to you that you may have overlooked before?
2. What does God reveal about himself in his conversation with Moses?
3. What stands out to you about Moses' response to God's call? In what ways can you relate to Moses' response and excuses?
4. Moses is known as one of the greatest leaders in history. What does this story teach about leadership and dependence on God?
5. How does this story fit into the bigger story of the Bible? How does it point us to Jesus?



Reflect: As you consider this week's sermon or passage, how is God asking you to respond where you live, work, study, and play?
