



Read the story of Rahab and the Spies in **Joshua 2**



Discussion: Use the following questions to discuss with your family, friends and/or life group.

1. What details in the story stand out to you that you may have overlooked before?
2. What does Rahab's confession of faith (Joshua 2:9-11) tell us about what she believed about God?
3. Why do you think God chose someone like Rahab to play such a significant role in Israel's story?
4. How does this story fit into the bigger story of the Bible? How does it point us to Jesus?
5. How does Rahab's story challenge our assumptions about whom God can use for his good purposes?



Reflect: As you consider this week's sermon or passage, how is God asking you to respond where you live, work, study, and play?
