



Read the story of Noah in **Genesis 6-9**



Discussion: Use the following questions to discuss with your family, friends and/or life group.

1. When you think of the story of Noah and the flood, what comes to mind? What challenged your previous thoughts about his story after reading it again and/or listening to the sermon this week?
2. Why did God decide to destroy everything and everyone in the story? Why did God spare Noah?
3. What significance do you see in God's covenant with Noah after the flood?
4. What can we learn about God's character throughout this story?
5. How does this story fit into the bigger story of the Bible? How does it point us to Jesus?
