

BCA FAQs

Q: How much is it?

A: Almost every family qualifies to have their entire tuition covered. \$6166 through the Ohio EdChoice Scholarship, and the rest through the OCEN SGO Scholarship. Why wouldn't you want a free, private education for your child?

Q: Do I have to be a Christian to attend?

A: We welcome any and all students seeking to acquire a good education. Our hope is that you would have true relationship with Jesus Christ, but it's not our place to determine your eternal destination. Nevertheless, we have rules and standards that must be respected and followed, like any school.

Q: Is lunch provided?

Q: Do you offer transportation?

A: We do not. All parents are responsible for transportation.

Q: What are the school hours?

A: 8am-2:30pm. Doors opens at 7:45am, and there is not an aftercare program.
