QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. When you watch previews before the main attraction, what makes you want to see a movie? Does John's prologue to his Gospel make you want to read further? Why?
2. Modern evolutionary theory teaches that random and infinite chance mutations guided by natural selection (i.e. the strongest and fittest types survive) have created life as we know it. How might John respond to that story of Creation? What evidence would he give to the contrary?
3. Where do you see darkness in your world? In your life? Where do you see Christ dispelling darkness with his life?

4. How does Jesus being God affect how you see Him? How does his being fully human affect how you see him? How might your testimony contribute to others around you reaching a conclusion about Jesus? Have you offered it recently? Explain.
5. From this study, what did you learn that you didn't know before? **What surprised you? What encouraged you?**
