## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. How and when were you first confronted with the truth of who Jesus is? Were you converted immediately or was there a process where mental ascent to the truth of Jesus became heart conviction and led to a surrender of your will?
2. Saul was incredibly sincere, passionate, and highly religious—yet he was completely wrong. How does this passage challenge the cultural idea that "it doesn't matter what you believe, as long as you are sincere"? How can we ensure our own spiritual zeal is actually aligned with God's truth?

3. Notice Saul didn't just add Jesus to his existing lifestyle; his entire identity, purpose, and worldview were profoundly changed. What is the difference between a life that is truly converted by the gospel versus a life that is simply modified by religion? What did that shift look like in your own life?
4. Noticed the Lord repurposed Saul's intellect, tenacity and zeal after his conversion to advance the Gospel. What giftings and abilities has the Lord repurposed in your life to advance the Gospel? Are you currently using those gifts and abilities in service of the Lord?
