The design of the tet is like a pot, a vessel with an inverted rim, **representing hidden or inverted goodness**. Another interpretation of the tet is that it represents a person bending their head to G-d in prayer and thanks ... The tet represents the hidden good that resides within the womb (the vessel) of the mother. This hidden good is actualized through a person's prayers to G-d, asking Him for a healthy child.




