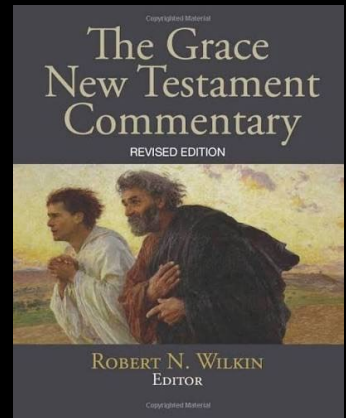
They are to examine themselves, not to determine if they are truly justified, but to see whether they are in the faith (en te pistei). Paul uses this expression four times in his epistles. He commands believers to “stand fast in the faith” (1 Cor 16:13), to be “established in the faith” (Col 2:7), and to “be sound in the faith” (Titus 1:13).




They would have to test (prove) themselves. They must prove themselves much like they had challenged the apostle to prove that Christ was speaking through him (v 3). The next statement tells what they should prove. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.



He is challenging them as believers in Jesus Christ to examine themselves to see if Christ's abiding presence was manifested in them (John 15:3–4). If not, they would be disqualified (*adokimos*), a term that appears three times in the immediate context (vv 5–7). Paul desires for the church in Corinth and all believers to live pleasing and obedient lives to the Lord and therefore to receive His approval at the Judgment Seat of Christ.
