LESSON 1

BIBLE STORY The Bible is God's word.

MAIN IDEA God's plan is perfect.
(See Psalm 18:30)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 12-17 The Story and The Song

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

Repeat the phrase "The Bible is God's word."

3. PRAYER & CRAFT

Pray to end your story time.

LESSON 2

BIBLE STORY

God creates the world.

MAIN IDEA

God made everything!
(See Genesis 1)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 18-24 The Beginning; A Perfect Home (part 1)

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

REMEMBER, "God made everything!" Take some time to talk about favorite animals and beautiful mountains and rivers and flowers. Remind kids that God made them all.

LESSON 3

BIBLE STORY

God creates people.

MAIN IDEA

God made everything!
(See Genesis 1 & 2)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 25-27 The Beginning; A Perfect Home (part 2)

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

Take time to point at each child and say their name with the phrase, "God made ---!"

Pray to end your story time.

LESSON 4

BIBLE STORY

Adam and Eve sin in the garden.

MAIN IDEA

Sin makes God sad.

(See Genesis 3 & Romans 3:23)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 28-33 The Terrible Lie (part 1)

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

***TEACHER'S NOTE:** Make sure to define what sin is while discussing this story with the kids. Some kids may know the answer, try and use words they know to explain, "doing bad things," "things that don't make God happy with us," etc.

BIBLE STORY

Adam and Eve leave the garden and God gives them a special promise.

MAIN IDEA

Sin makes God sad.
(See Genesis 3 & Romans 3:23)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 34-37 The Terrible Lie (part 2)

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

BIBLE STORY

Noah builds an ark.

MAIN IDEA

God is good.
(See Genesis 6-9)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 38-47 A New Beginning: Noah's Ark

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

God makes all things new! Talk about the changing of seasons... what happens in the winter? (everything dies. snow covers the ground.) What happens in the spring? (The grass starts to grow. Flowers pop up out of the ground. The sun starts to get warm again). Just like the changing of seasons, God makes ALL things new again.

BIBLE STORY

The people build a tall tower.

MAIN IDEA

Jesus is the king!
(See Genesis 11 and John 14:6)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 48-55 A Giant Staircase to Heaven: The Tower of Babel

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children.

Take time to ask each child,

"Do you believe that Jesus is the King of kings?"

BIBLE STORY

God tells Abraham that he will have a big family!

MAIN IDEA

God is good.
(See Genesis 12-21 and Matthew 7:11)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 56-61 Son of Laughter: God's Special Promise to Abraham

BIBLE STORY Abraham, Isaac and the sacrifice.

MAIN IDEA I will follow Jesus.
(See Genesis 22 and Mark 12:30)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

BIBLE STORY

Joseph forgives his brothers.

MAIN IDEA

Jesus loves me.
(See Genesis 37-46)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 76-83 The Forgiving Prince

GIVING THANKS

Teachers will guide children through a morning of thanksgiving as we enter into the Christmas season.

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. MAIN IDEA

THANK YOU GOD!

3. STORY & SNACK

Read the book "Good, Good Father" By Chris Tomlin.

Talk about different reasons we can be thankful to God.

Example: Thank you God that you are kind, that you love us. Thank you God that you are strong and protect us. Thank you God for healing us, forgiving us, and teaching us. Thank you God for feeding us. Thank you God for music and fun. Thank you God for being a friend. Thank you God for listening.

4. CRAFT
