LESSON 22

BIBLE STORY

MAIN IDEA

I will follow Jesus.
(Matthew 4, Mark 1, Luke 4-6)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 208 - 213 Let's Go!

AND Luke 5:4-7 at the appropriate part in the story.

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children. **Paraphrase the story when needed.**

Following Jesus can be very hard when you have to leave things behind like the fishermen did. But following Jesus is wonderful too! It's like being a part of a great adventure! Will you choose to follow Jesus too?

MAIN IDEA

God takes care of me.
(Luke 8)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 214 - 221 A Little Girl and a Poor Frail Lady

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children. **Paraphrase the story when needed.**

Have you ever had a scrape or a bump? An owie you got from falling down? Were you ever sick in bed for a whole day or two? Do you know someone who is sick right now? Did you know that Jesus is the healer and can make owies better! He can also make sad hearts feel better too. Let's pray that Jesus would heal the people who are hurting and sad.

BIBLE STORY

The Lord's Prayer

MAIN IDEA

God hears our prayers.
(Matthew 6)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Do not worry.

MAIN IDEA

God takes care of me.
(Matthew 6,9, and Luke 12)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Let's make a Bible with our hands.

Have children make a Bible with their hands.

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Open Bible. (Use the Jesus Storybook Bible that is provided).

READ: Pages 228 - 235 The Singer

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children. **Paraphrase the story when needed.**

Remind children that God knows exactly what we need, and He knows we need Him the most! Let's pray together thanking God for the things he has given to us and for taking care of us. Spend some time praying as a class (you can even encourage a couple of the older children in class to pray out loud as well).

MAIN IDEA

God is with me.
(See Mark 4, Matthew 8)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children. **Paraphrase the story when needed.**

The people on the boat were so afraid! But who was on the boat with them? JESUS, YES! Is Jesus with you -name- when you are afraid? Yes. Give each kid a chance to answer the question. Jesus can make us feel at peace (calm) and safe.

MAIN IDEA

(See Matthew 14, Mark 6, Luke 9)

1. PRAYER & WORSHIP

Ask children to fold their hand and bow their heads. Have a teacher say a short prayer. Encourage children to join in worship by clapping, singing or dancing along to the worship songs. (Worship songs will be on the DVDs provided in the classroom).

2. STORY & SNACK

Hold up the Bible. What is this? (The Bible)

Is everything in the Bible true? (Yes, everything in the Bible is true!)

I have a special marker in my Bible marking a very important story.

READ: Pages 244 - 249 Filled Full!

Make sure to use expression, and pause for children to repeat things, make different noises, etc to make the story more interesting and engaging for the children. **Paraphrase the story when needed.**

The people in this story were so hungry as they listened to Jesus teach. Do you think Jesus knew they were hungry? YES. He is God and He knows everything! Do you think He knows what you need all the time too? YES. God takes care of you -name-. (Do this for each child).
