

2. Read Exodus 30:17-38: G-D required His priests to wash themselves and anoint themselves and all the furniture in the Tabernacle. What does this show us about how G-D likes things to be?
3. Read Exodus 31:1-11: Oholiab and Bezalel were gifted artisans. What talents has the Father given you? How do you use these talents to serve Him and others around you?
4. Read Exodus 31:12-17: How do you honor Shabbat? What are the benefits of keeping this day set apart for G-D?
5. Read Exodus 32: Why was G-D angry at the Israelites? How did Moshe react to G-D's threat to destroy them for their idol worship?
