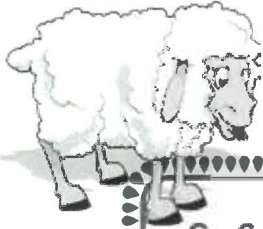

1. Read Leviticus 21:1-22:33: G-D lays out His standards for the priesthood. What sacrifices are you prepared to make in your life to serve the Father?
2. Read Leviticus 23:3: The Shabbat is one of Yah's Appointed Times. How do you honor the Shabbat each week?
3. Read Leviticus 23:4-8: Why do you think the Father asked the Israelites to eat bread without leaven (yeast) during the Feast of Unleavened Bread?
4. Read Leviticus 23:33-43: G-D asked the Israelites to live in temporary dwellings for seven days during the Feast of Sukkot (Tabernacles). How do you celebrate Sukkot? What temporary dwelling do you live in?
5. Read Leviticus 23 and Acts 2:1, 20-21: How long did G-D expect His people to honor His Feasts (Appointed Times)? How did Yeshua and His disciples honor the Feasts?
