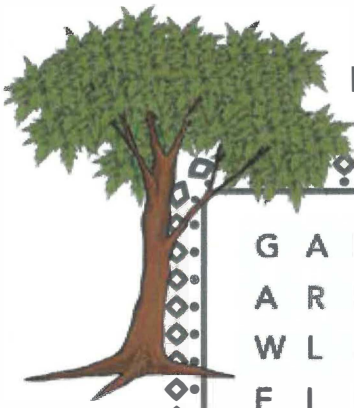

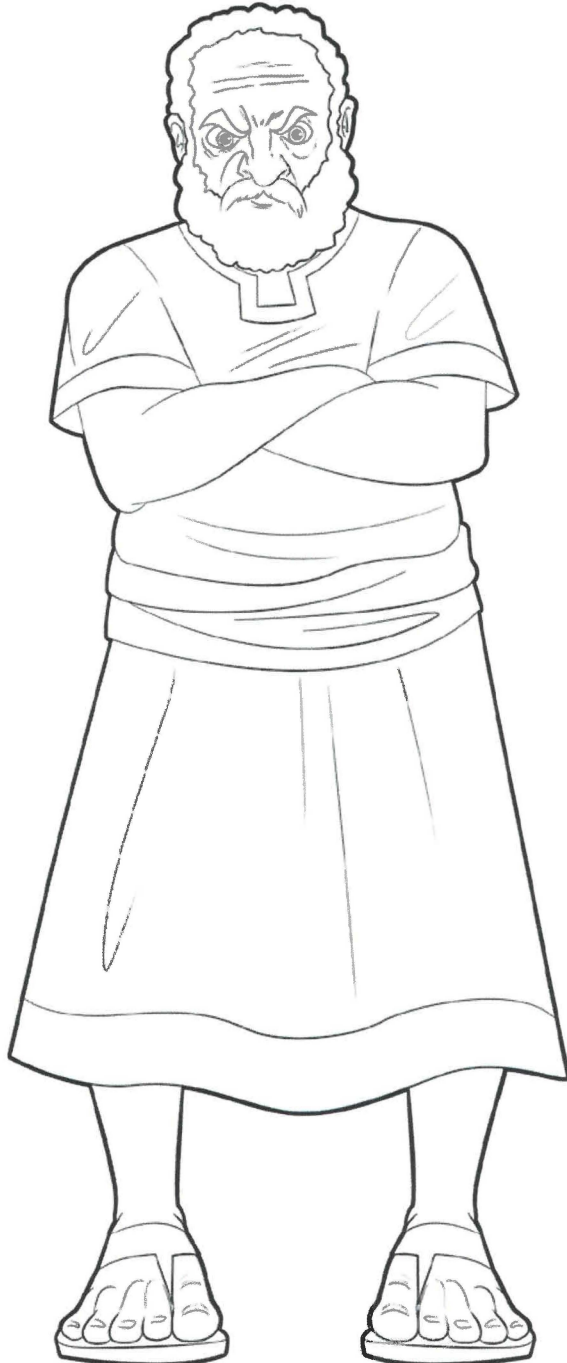

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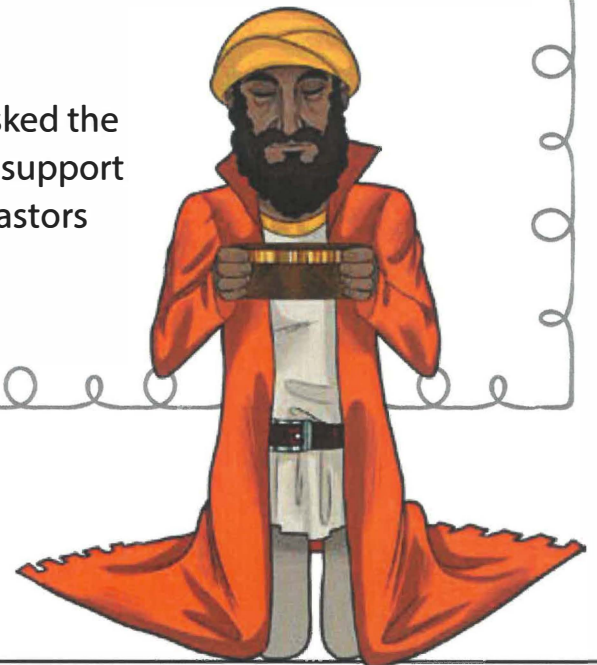
3. How did G-D punish Korah and the rebels? (verse 32)

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## LET'S DISCUSS: KORACH

Open your Bibles and read the Bible verses below.  
Discuss these questions with your family, friends, and classmates.

1. Read Numbers 16:1-50: Korah and his rebels didn't like the leadership that G-D had established. Who else rebelled against Moshe and Aharon? What did they accuse Moshe of doing?
2. Read Numbers 16:1-50: When you are falsely accused, how do you react?
3. Read Numbers 16:1-11: How did Moshe react to Korah's false accusations?
4. Read Numbers 16:31-50: Was G-D pleased or displeased with Korah's behavior? How did He deal with their behavior?
5. Read Numbers 16: 1-50, 1 Timothy 3:1-13, and 5:17-18: What does G-D look for in a good leader? How do you honor leadership that G-D has put in place in your family, school, and congregation?
6. Read Numbers 18:21 and 1 Timothy 5:17-18: G-D asked the Israelites to give a tithe (a tenth) of their income to support the Levites. How do you and your family support pastors and teachers in your congregation?
