HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF IYYAR

This month's letter of the alef-bet is alef. It is the first letter of the alef-bet. Say: "AH-lef". This letter makes no sound but the sound of the nikud (like vowels in English) under or nearby the letter. The letter alef looks like it points both up and down representing both heaven and the earth, or the way G-D is a once above us, and right next to us at all times. It is the first letter in the word El, El-him and Ad-nai all of which are words we use for G-D. We make the sound of the alef in various ways, but when we pronounce it with the chirik and tsere we do so by smiling with the front of our tongue against the back of our top teeth and making an ee or an eh sound with our voices. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, and then look at the items that begin with this soundless but important letter; you can read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF IYYAR

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say "alef" then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.

Note all these start with the long ē sound

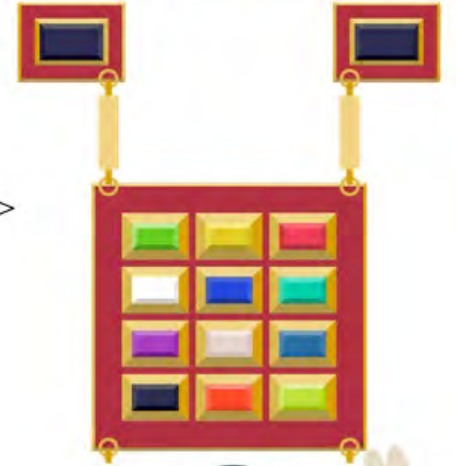
