HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF TAMUZ

This month's letter is yod the smallest, yet one of the mightiest letters, of the alef-bet. Mighty because though it is small and humble it is the beginning of some the greatest names in the whole universe! Like G-D's name, and Yeshua. Yisrael, Yerushalyim, and Yehudim! It is the tenth letter of the alef-bet. This letter makes a sound that is identical to our English letter "y" and often acts in a similar manner of our "y" in that it sometimes makes the ee sound too. We make the common sound of the yod in the back of our throat by pressing the center of our tongue up in our mouths and voicing a blast of air past our slightly open teeth. The yod is actually famous as Yeshua HIMSELF said: "¹⁸Amen, I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or serif shall ever pass away from the Torah until all things come to pass." in Mattiyahu 5:18. He said the word yod in speaking of "the smallest letter" of the alef-bet. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, it is wearing a special sash in honor of a big birthday this year, and then look at the items that begin with this small but mighty letter; you can read. remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.
