HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF TAMUZ

This month’s letter is lamed is the tallest letter of the alef-bet, and the only letter to go above the upper line when we are printing. It is the 12th letter of the alef-bet. This upstanding letter makes a sound that is very like our English letter "l". We make this sound of lamed by pressing the front third of our tongue up in our mouths and bringing the voice over our middle teeth. The word lamed comes from a root that means "to teach":lahmahd, and the original pictograph is a shepherds rod used to make the sheep move forward. Many words in Ivrit begin with lamed, and it is also used as a special beginning called a prefix. When we see lamed followed by an apostrophe, it modifies the word it is attached to and means, among other things "to", "for", or "from" that thing or place. Lamed is a really fun letter that does a lot of great work. We can move our learning forward by tracing and using the letter lamed. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, and then look at the items that begin with the tall letter lamed; you can read the names aloud and run your finger underneath the letters as you read. Remember.  that Hebrew, unlike English, is read from right to left.

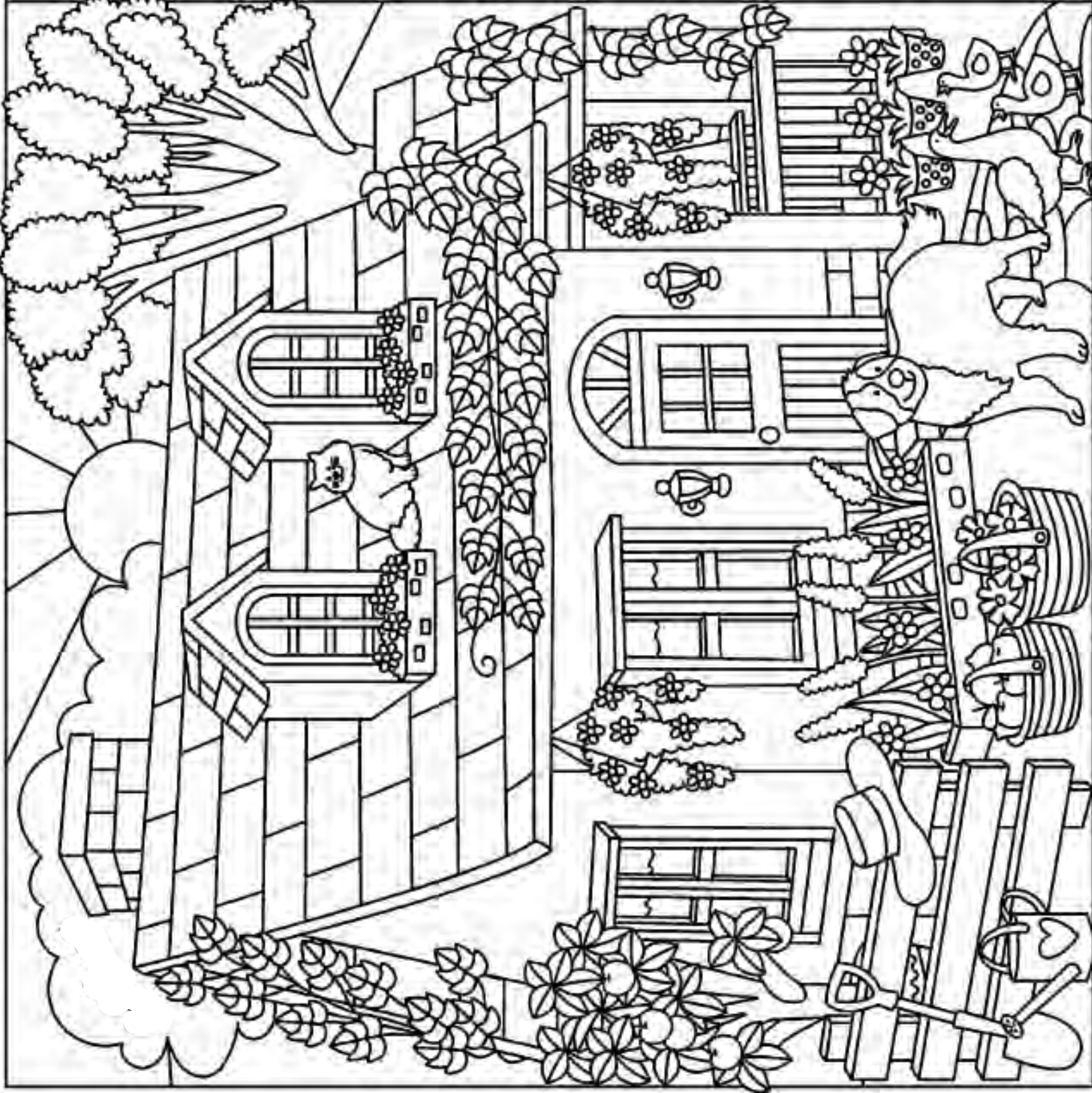
