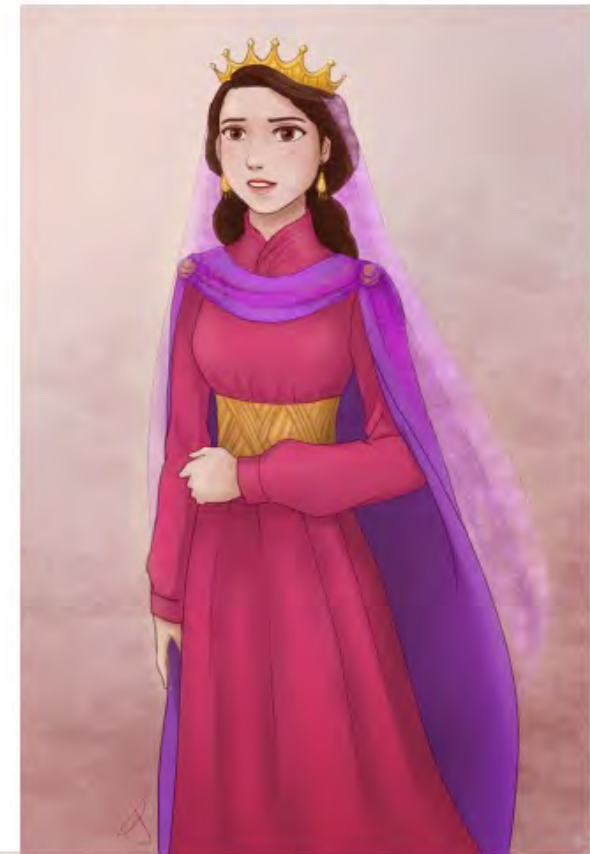
מְזוּזָה (mezzuZAH)

 5. Ye - shua loves me! He will stay Close be - side me all the way;

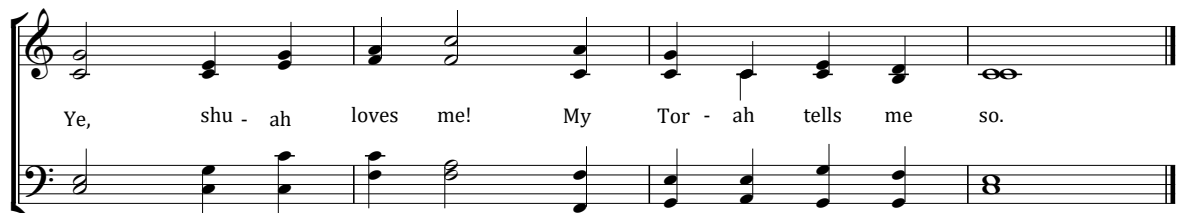


Lit - tle ones to Him be - long; They are weak, but He is strong.
