HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF SIVAN

This month's letter of the alef-bet is quf sometimes spelled kuf with a k in some transliterations. It is the nineteenth letter of the alef-bet. Say: "koof". This letter makes a sound that is similar English letter "q" or "k". We make the sound of the quf in the back of our throat by pressing the center of our tongue down in our mouths and forcing a blast of air past our slightly open teeth. The quf sound is voiceless which means without nikudim (vowel sounds) it doesn't make more than a whisper. Like it's English equivalent sound "Q" not very many words in Hebrew begin with the quf, but you will find it inside many words as the qu sound. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, and then look at the items that begin with this fun letter; you can read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF NISAN

Show them the picture. Trace the letter with your finger and say "koof" then take their index finger and gently trace over the letter, repeat.

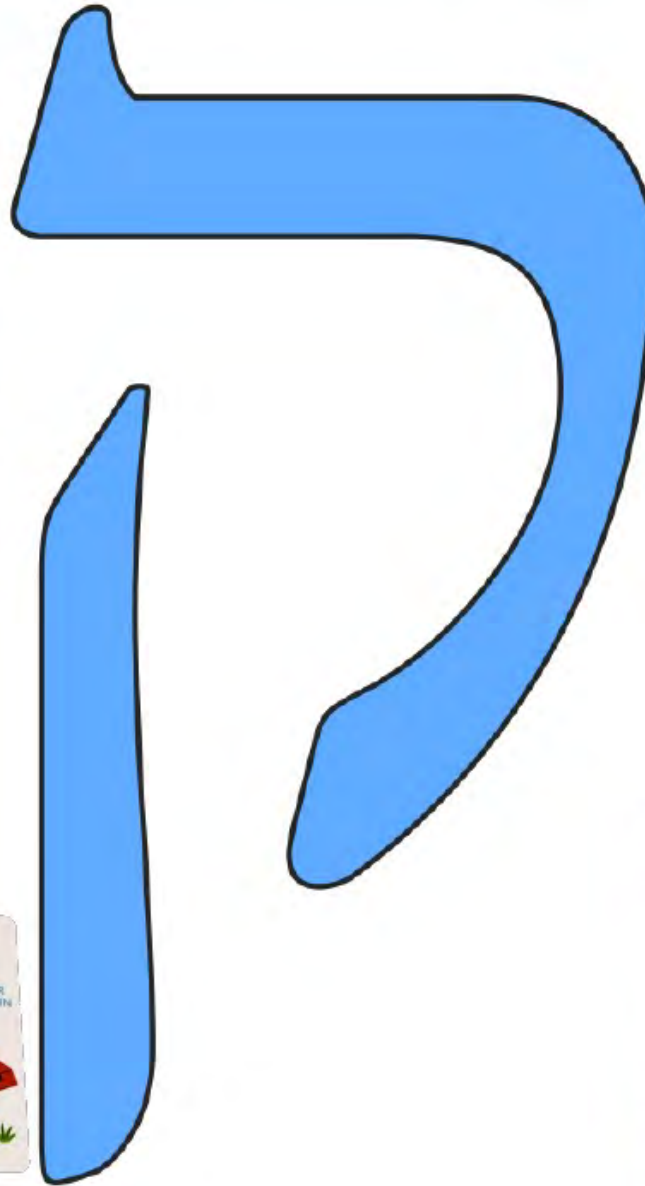

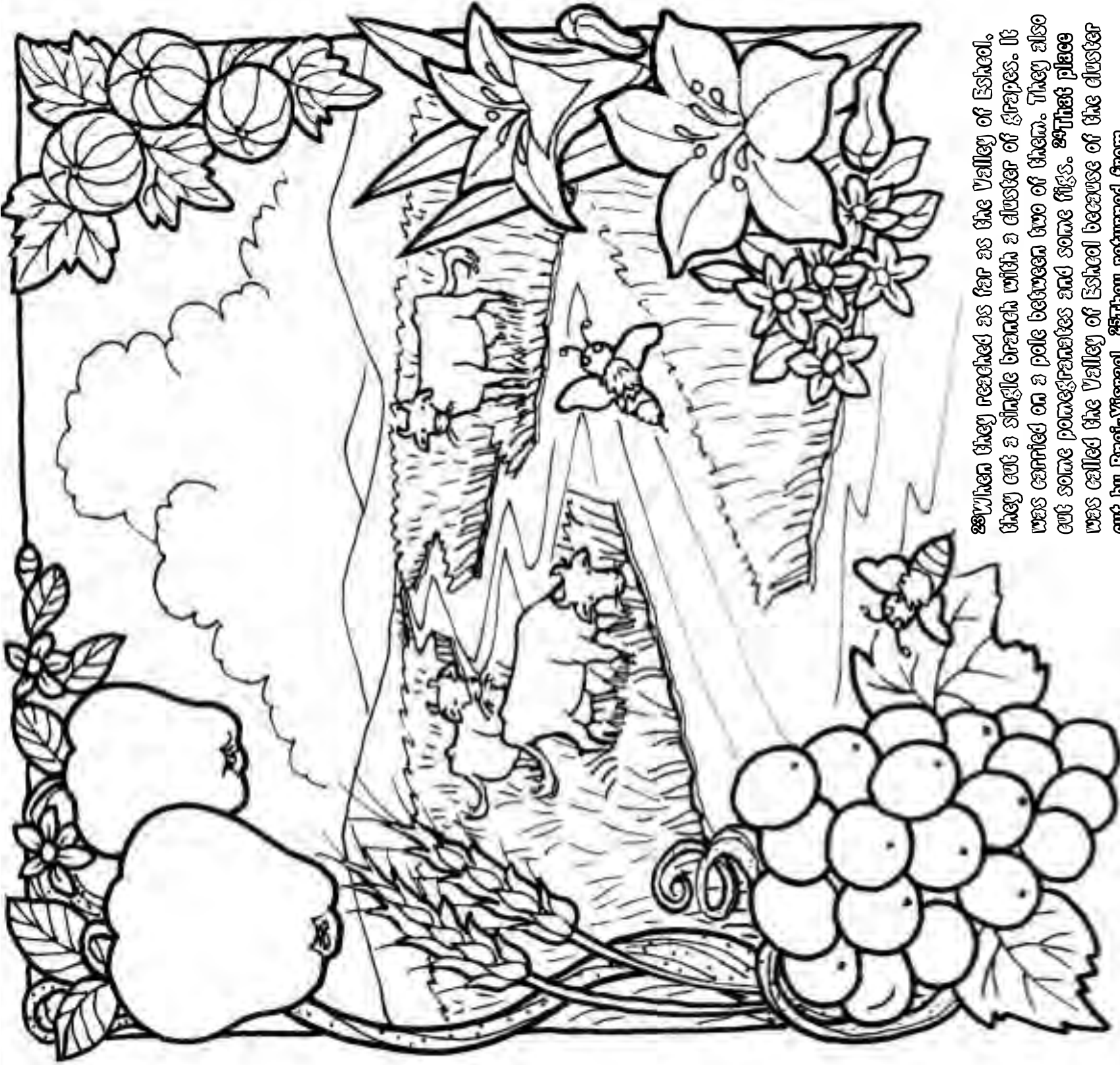
