HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF NISAN

This month's letter of the alef-bet is zayin. It is the seventh letter of the alef-bet. Say: "zAH-yeen". This letter makes the ticklish buzzing sound that is represented in English by the letter "Z". The letter zayin is said to look like a crowned vav, it is said to represent a sword but also paradoxically nourishment. This is intriguing because ever since our ancestors fell in Gan Eden by seeking nourishment from the forbidden fruit of the tree, there has been an angel with a sword guarding our re-entry into that place. G-D also made our discipline that we will fight the earth (go to war) to receive nourishment from it. The zayin holds many stories for such a small letter. We make the sound by smiling with the front of our tongue against the back of our top teeth and making a buzzing sound with a hum out of our belly. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, and then look at the items that begin with this small letter; you can read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.
