## HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF NISAN

This month's letter of the alef-bet is zayin. It is the seventh letter of the alef-bet. Say: "zAH-yeen". This letter makes the ticklish buzzing sound that is represented in English by the letter "Z". The letter zayin is said to look like a crowned vav, it is said to represent a sword but also paradoxically nourishment. This is intriguing because ever since our ancestors fell in Gan Eden by seeking nourishment from the forbidden fruit of the tree, there has been a angel with at sword guarding our re-entry into that place. G-D also made our discipline that we will fight the earth (go to war) to receive nourishment from it. The zayin holds many stories for such a small letter. We make the sound by smiling with the front of our tongue against the back of our top teeth and making a buzzing sound with a hum out of our belly. Use your finger to trace it on the next page, and then look at the items that begin with this small letter; you can read the names aloud? Run your finger underneath the letters and remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.
