INTRODUCTION "OPENING" 5 MINUTES	Say to them: "Shalom Yeladim" (sha-LOAM Ye-la-DEEM). Invite them to respond: "Shalom Morim!"	Say Shema, Pledge of Allegiance. Query to think about: How does our obedience and the blessings we receive represent G-D to non- believers?

IDENTITY: BELIEVER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: What are all the blessings that are promised? What are the curses that will follow if we fail to obey G-D?	Discuss: What does it mean to represent G-D's character? What does the Shema mean? What does it mean to be a cheerful giver?
IDENTITY: FOLLOWER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: Where is the comfort for b'nei Yisrael?	Discuss: What are the ways that G-D shows HIS character?

IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we leave all we have and follow HIM!	Ask: Shimon just had the best "business" day of his life, what did he do, next? (buy a Maserati? a mansion? go on a lux vacay? Star in a TikTok "making it rain"?)
GAME/ACTIVITY	Inherited Blessings	<<-what blessings do we take for granted?
HOMEWORK 3 MINUTES	Super Quick Torah Study -Mattiyahu 26 "Shavua tov, until next week!"	Close with prayer: say out loud what you are grateful for and things you need prayer for today.

NOTES

The first goal is to approach all scripture with humility and prayer.

One of the most amazing things about Ad-nai is His amazing ability to completely bless His people. This weeks Parsha begins with one of His promises to do just that. It begins in Deuteronomy 7:12:

12“Then it will happen, as a result of your listening to these ordinances, when you keep and do them, that Adonai your God will keep with you the covenant kindness that He swore to your fathers.”

Notice that these words come in the text that explains how Israel is supposed to reject the way of the people of Caanan and live only according to Ad-nai's commandments. The result of choosing Ad-nai's ways over the worlds ways is that Ad-nai will keep us with His covenant of kindness.

We often think in terms of the Torah being a covenant of Laws and restrictions but Ad-ani thinks of it in terms of kindness. Maybe we should allow Him to change our perspective?
