INTRODUCTION "OPENING" 5 MINUTES	Say to them: "Shalom Yeladim" (sha-LOAM Ye-la-DEEM). Invite them to respond: "Shalom Morim!"	Say Shema, Pledge of Allegiance. Query to think about: Have we ever wondered about our motivation?

I will strengthen you. Surely I will help you. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.
IDENTITY: BELIEVER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: What are the laws you remember from this reading?	Discuss: What do each of these laws protect? What does G-D value in us that these laws protect?
IDENTITY: FOLLOWER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: Who does G-D have compassion on?	Discuss: Are we expected to show this same compassion for others?

IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we act in a manner fitting our Royal station in the Kingdom!	Ask: What are the daily ways we represent The Kingdom of G-D??

NOTES

The first goal is to approach all scripture with humility and prayer.

I know that as young people you are constantly told by adults what the rules are. You have to do this. You must do that. You cannot do this.

The list of rules can sometimes be difficult for you to keep up with. However, every one of these rules can be important and some of them are designed to keep you safe and alive.

I also know that your *choosing* to obey the rules is based upon your spiritual condition. When we are rebellious and angry at our parents, we often will choose to do the exact things they told us not to.

When we are not angry or upset with our parents, we are able to obey the rules no matter how difficult they might be for us. All laws and rules are spiritual, and our physical obedience corresponds to our spiritual health.
