INTRODUCTION "OPENING" 5 MINUTES	Say to them: "Shalom!" (sha-LOAM). Tell them how to respond: Shalom	Say Shema, Pledge of Allegiance. Query to think about: What does it mean to repent and seek G-D?

IDENTITY: FOLLOWER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Ask: What secular assumption does Eli the Kohen Gadol make about Hannah?	Discuss: Who does Hannah's baby become? Does he follow the secular example of Eli's sons?
IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD 5 MINUTES	Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we live as an outsider in this fallen land.	Discuss: What does a blast of the shofar signify?
GAME/ACTIVITY	Living as an Outsider	<<<How then shall we live?
HOMEWORK 3 MINUTES	Our letter of the month is vav. Look around shul for something that begins with the vav. "Shavua tov, until next week!"	Close with prayer: say out loud what you are grateful for and things you need prayer for today.
