The first goal is to approach all scripture with humility and prayer.

Have your parents ever told you that something great is going to happen but while you were waiting for it to take place you began to doubt that it would ever happen?

Maybe you thought it would cost too much. Maybe you thought it would be too hard to do. Maybe you thought you were too young or too small.

Well, this is exactly what we are reading about in our Torah Parsha this week in Parsha Sh'lach. Moses is sending men in to look at the land of Israel to see if it was all that Ad-nai promised it would be.

It was, but as they looked around they found all kinds of different reasons why they would not be able to receive what was promised. We always need to remember that faith requires us to trust Ad-nai's promises more than what we can see or can do.
