<p>IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD</p> <p>5 MINUTES</p>	<p>Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we put G-D's law above all else and honor HIS word.</p>	<p>Ask: Do we violate the law of G-D for the sake of our tradition?</p>

NOTES

The first goal is to approach all
scripture with humility and prayer.

Have you ever been told that before you could get something that you wanted you would have to first do something? Maybe it was that you cannot have dessert until you eat your vegetables. Or maybe it was you cannot go out to play until you have cleaned your room. Well there are spiritual things that work in the very same way: as we read in Vayikra 9:6:

Moses said, "This is what Adonai commanded that you should do, so that the glory of Adonai may appear to you."

The Children of Israel wanted the glory of Ad-nai to appear. Moses told them that before they would see the glory of Ad-ani they needed to draw near, offer a sin offering, a burnt offering and make atonement. This is the same thing we do when we accept Yeshua as our Messiah, repent of our sins and accept His atonement.
