<p>IDENTITY: FOLLOWER OF G-D'S WORD</p> <p>5 MINUTES</p>	<p>Ask: What is the penalty for sin? What is required even for unintentional sin?</p>	<p>Discuss: How are we "clothed in righteousness"?</p>
<p>IDENTITY: DOER OF G-D'S WORD</p> <p>5 MINUTES</p>	<p>Who we are is largely dependent upon what we do; we put our faith in Yeshua and allow Him to clothe us in righteousness.</p>	<p>Ask: Do our outer garments always reflect an inner reality?</p>
<p>GAME/ACTIVITY</p>	<p>Does G-D really care about...?</p>	<p>&lt;&lt;-what does care about?</p>
<p>HOMEWORK</p> <p>3 MINUTES</p>	<p>Our letter of the month of Nisan is samech. Look around shul for something that begins with the sound like the English letter "s"; "Shavua tov, until next week!"</p>	<p>Close with prayer: say out loud what you are grateful for and things you need prayer for today.</p>

Have your parents ever looked at you and said: "You are going to have to change your clothes."

Did you know that in this week's Parsha the priest had to change his clothes while he was making the burnt offering? In Leviticus chapter 6:4 we read:

**"Then he is to take off his garments, put on other ones, and carry the ashes outside the camp to a clean place."**

We know from our studies that everything the priests did point in some way to Yeshua and what He would do. In this case, the priest had to offer an offering and then change clothes to complete the offering. If we read about Yeshua when He returns He is wearing the clean white robes of a priest. Yeshua had to change his clothes.
