

In Torah, and in life, false prophets are people who claim to speak the Word of God but instead spread lies, false messages, and teachings. False prophets were also people who spoke on behalf of and promoted false gods (demons). These false gods want to control our behaviour and thoughts for their own evil purposes, to destroy us and the people that G-D loves (also us) Matthew 7:15-16



Truth VS Falsehood

Presented here is a simple test to see if the teacher, prophet or "god" is a true one or not. Study G-D's WORD! If you know the truth you cannot be deceived by lies and all that is not true because it will ring false in your ears.

Truth will:

- Always affirm HIS exclusivity (Deuteronomy 6:4-9), will never say that there is any other way besides Yeshua HaMashiach to salvation (John 14:6). Liars love to say that this is unfair, nonetheless this is TRUTH.
- Never contradict HIS explicit word found exclusively in HIS Torah, will never need "another book" to prove HIS word.
- Never tell you to do something that is a sin (Romans 6:1-2), or tell you you do not need to repent of a sin you have already committed, if someone is encouraging you to do something that is bad in G-D's book, or that something you did is "totally fine" without your honest repentance they are NOT from G-D.
- Never humiliate you, demoralize you, or call you names, while it is true that HE chastises those HE loves (Hebrews 12:10), HE never does so in a demeaning way and it is always to correct a wrong you have done.
- Never tell you to hate someone (their sin, yes, but not them), if someone is encouraging you to hate another person, for any reason at all, you know that they are not of G-D (Matthew 5:44).
- Never say someone can't be saved, or is beyond hope. (2 Peter 3:9), if someone is still alive they can be redeemed, they can be saved, no matter what their past or present situation.
- Never tell you to doubt His Torah, HIS will, or His way. (James 1:6-7) Doubt never comes from G-D! The serpent asked Chava, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from all the trees of the garden'?" hasatan and his agents uses the same tactic today, making us doubt what G-D has said.
- Never tell you to disobey godly authority. (Romans 13:1-2) very often false teachers seek to erode the G-Dly authorities power over us, they tell us we deserve "freedom" when they are actually selling us into slavery to a false god(demon).
- Never tell you HE doesn't love you. (1 John 4:16) G-D loves us, despite our flaws, weaknesses, and even our sin. Any voice telling you that G-D doesn't love you is selling you something you DO NOT WANT.
