Icebreaker:

What is your favorite thing to clean? What is your least favorite thing to clean? Why?

Discussion Questions:

1. Consider listening to *The Farewell Discourse* (John 13-17) together. If you listen online or on your Bible app, it should take about 20 minutes.
2. Read John 13:1-20 together.
3. In 1st century culture, washing the feet of houseguests was the most humbling activity of a servant. What would be a modern corollary?

What about this modern activity is so lowly, humbling, or disgusting?

4. If you were Peter, would you have reacted as he did? Why or why not?
5. Jesus calls us to imitate him in humble service and self-denial (vs. 14). In what ways have others served you in extravagant and self-giving ways?
6. Abiding with Jesus means growing in our humble service and self-denial. In what ways does spending more time with Jesus increase your bandwidth for these two traits?
7. In what ways does your small group currently serve others?

How do these activities help you feel closer to Jesus?

In what ways can your small group increase in your collective humble service and self-denial?
