Small Group Questions
Week of August 9, 2026**

Icebreaker:

What is the strangest piece of clothing you have in your closet?

What is a new skill you picked up later in life?

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Luke 24:13-35 together.
2. Pretend to eavesdrop on these two disciples: What things are they likely talking about as they walk (vs. 19-24)? What tones of voice do you hear? What hopes are dashed? What plans might they be making? How do they react to the “stranger”?
3. When have you been disappointed in your faith journey? How did you recover from the disappointment? Did someone come alongside you? As appropriate, take time to pray for one another in those seasons of disappointment.
4. The Emmaus disciples had to learn that suffering was a part of Jesus’ place in God’s story. Why are we tempted to think that following Jesus doesn’t include suffering? How can this truth help us follow Jesus better?
5. What is your “Road to Emmaus” – a place where Jesus surprised you recently? What happened?
6. Have you been reminded of the hope of Jesus recently? Take time to share these stories.
7. Pray to close! Pray for each other that God would give transformation, perspective, and hope because of the presence of Jesus.
