Icebreaker:

Share about a time when you got lost. How did you find your way back to where you were going?

Discussion Questions:

1. Read John 14:1-14: What do you think is the main idea of this passage?

What is one or two things that jumps out at you as significant from this passage?

2. Jesus says, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life.” What do you think each of those three descriptions means?

Which one speaks most meaningfully to you right now, and why?

3. Philip asks Jesus, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.” Jesus responds by pointing Philip back to Himself. What does this teach us about who Jesus is and what it means to know God?

4. Why do you think Jesus would tell His disciples that they would do “greater works” than He had done?

How might this encourage us to see our ordinary acts of service, love, witness, and ministry as part of Jesus' ongoing work?

5. What do you think Jesus means when He says, “I go to prepare a place for you”?

How might the cross, resurrection fit into this idea of Jesus preparing the way for us to be with Him?

6. Sometimes we can become more excited about the blessings Jesus gives than about Jesus Himself. What are some ways Christians can accidentally make the destination more important than the person?

7. If Jesus isn't merely the one who shows us the way but is Himself the way—and the One we're ultimately going to be with, how does that change what it means for you to follow Jesus today?
