Beginning Memorial Day weekend and continuing through Labor Day weekend, our Sunday morning worship schedule will move to **one blended worship service at 9:30 am**. 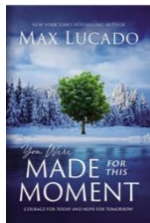

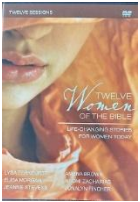

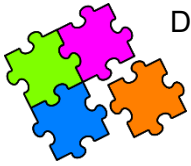
