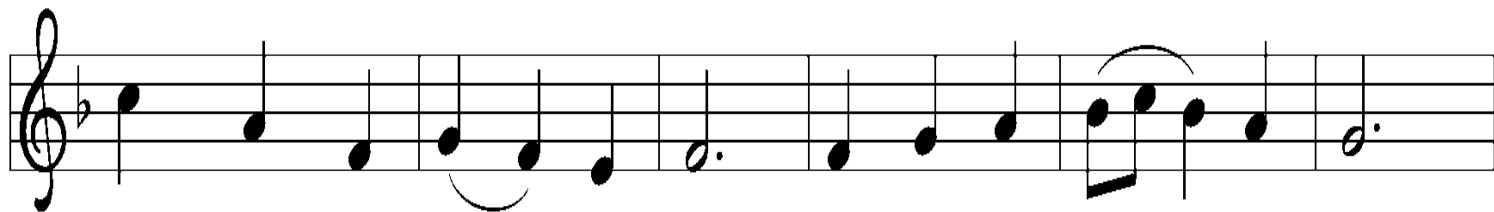

Most Merciful God,

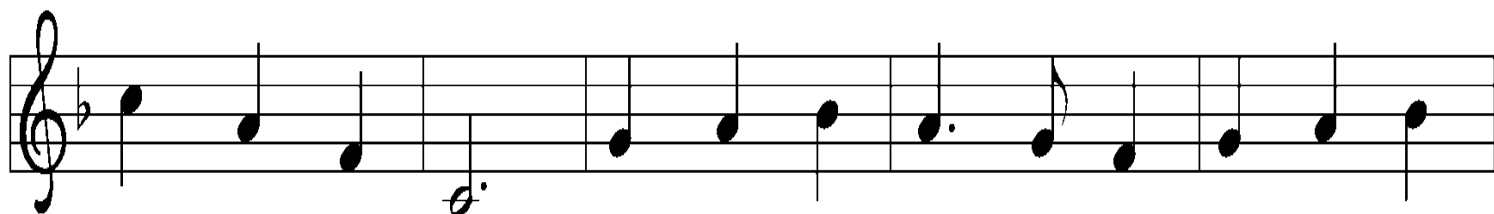

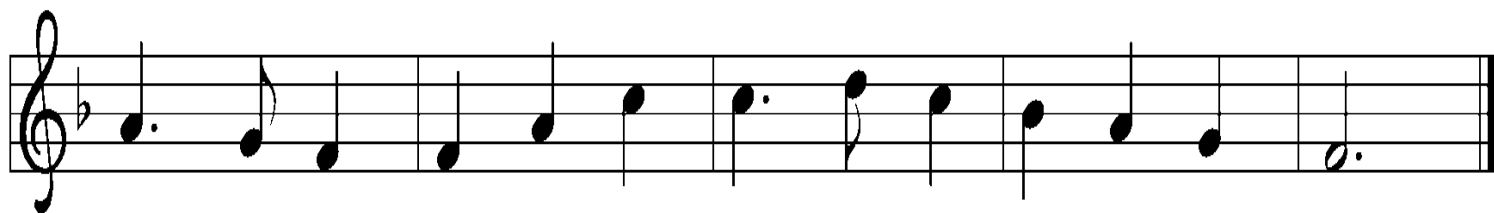

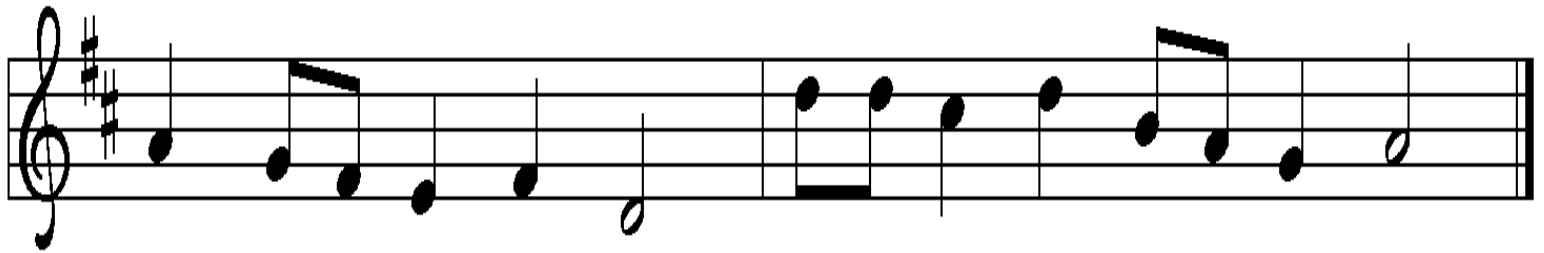

### **Glory to you, O Lord**

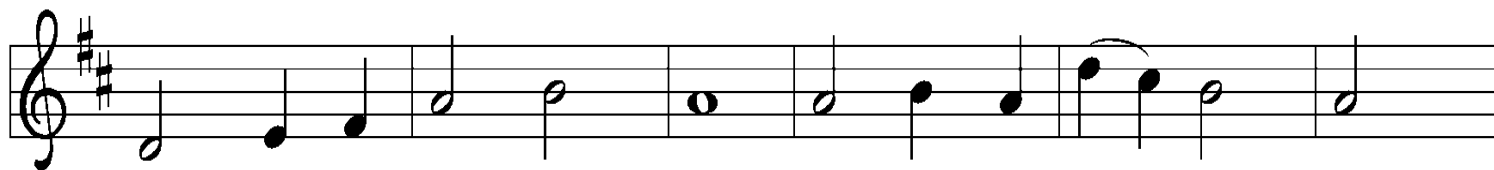
