

ANNUAL MEETING AND DISCERNMENT DISCUSSION

On March 25 the Annual Meeting of the Congregation was held. A quorum was verified. All reports, minutes and treasurer's reports were accepted by the congregation. Trudy Archer and Jim Kreger were nominated and approved to be our representatives at Synod Assembly in June. The meeting was adjourned and we then proceeded to have a light lunch prior to Rev. Khader El-Yateem, Assistant to the Bishop, opening a discussion on how we might move forward as a congregation. He presented a slide show asking us to think about what God wants for us, who is our neighbor, what is the makeup of our congregation, who could we strategically partner with and do our facilities meet our needs.

From Church Council President

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In Peter's Second Letter, he insisted we "not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead, he is patient with you." What exactly does this mean? I would suggest that God isn't late with his promise as some measure of lateness. He has his own sense of timing and rather than rush forward to some end, God is holding back because of us. He's giving us the space and time to change. He is allowing us to discern what the future will look like for St. Peter Lutheran on Ft. Myers Beach.

On Saturday, March 25th over 30 members and friends participated in a discussion facilitated by Rev. Khader El-Yateem, the Director for Evangelical Mission and Assistant to the Bishop (South Region) from the Florida-Bahamas Synod. It was a productive working lunch as we made our first steps forward in discernment. It was clear that we are all anxious to get going. Yet, no one is totally sure what we should do.

It was evident from the discussion that there is much to consider. The future of St. Peter is not well defined and there is much to consider. Repairs will not be easily accomplished. It is much more complex than just repairing the building, as much depends on what the City of Ft. Myers Beach will permit us to do. As you may have read, the city is working to determine what will be allowed and not allowed. This is dependent upon many factors, such as the appraised value of each building, the determination of what parts of the building must be brought to current code, the new flood zones that went into effect in November, the structural soundness of each building independently, etc. While we do have a preliminary structural engineering report, it was paid for by the insurance company and may or may not have found all damages and necessary repairs. As part of our contract with Keys Claims, window experts and other engineers will perform additional assessments of our buildings. This will put St. Peter in the best position so we can move forward.

Again, I would like to thank you for your support. We appreciate your patience and welcome your prayers. We must continue to prayerfully consider what God has planned in God's time while we continue our journey. Progress is being made and some recent steps are as follows:

- A settlement of \$500,000 (policy maximum) building and \$140,000 contents was received from flood claim.
- Keys Claims Consultants, LLC, has made a preliminary visit to the site and begun their documentation process to assist with furthering our wind claim.
- Council has begun the process of obtaining quotes for electrical work to get power hooked back up to the sanctuary.
- A discernment conversation was held on March 25th with Pastor El-Yateem.
- Council has obtained two roofing quotes.
- Council has met on site with a general contractor and architect and are awaiting preliminary repair costs.
- Sunday parking lot services were held in March and will continue through April.
