This unwelcomed trauma provides us with an opportunity to use our Lenten season to reflect on our faith in and beyond the storm. Church Council Minutes from December 15, 2022

Members present: Jason Kurtz, Mark Venturin, Jim Look, Arlene Burm, Jana Clevenger, Pastor Sharon Taylor, Lynn Larson and Rhona Diamond (by zoom).

The meeting was called to order at 5:28 p.m. by president Jason Kurtz. Devotions and prayer were given by Pastor Sharon Taylor.

A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Mark to approve the agenda for the meeting.

Motion passed.

A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Lynn to approve the December 3, 2022 anniversary meeting minutes. Motion passed. The November 18, 2022 minutes were approved electronically on November 21, 2022.

A motion was made by Arlene and seconded by Jim To approve the November 30, 2022 treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Mutual Ministry: The services of Amy Colon, custodian, were severed in September after the hurricane but she will receive compensation until the end of the year, the last check dated

December 15.

Social Ministry: WELCA will not meet until February.

Worship and Music: there will be a Christmas Eve worship service at 10:00 on Saturday, Dec. 24 in the St. Peter parking lot. Congregants are also invited to worship at Lamb of God at either 4:00 or 6:00 with pastors Tim and Sharon Taylor.

Old Business:

A. Insurance: we are still owed a refund from Weston Wind insurance policy cancelled in July, 2022 which was replaced by Citizens in September, 2022. We are also owed a refund from the appraisal company Maxwell-Simmons because the appraisal was not done by the time of the hurricane. Jason made a motion and Arlene seconded to hire a public adjustor to act as a liaison between the insurance companies and St Peter.

Motion passed.

B. Christmas bonuses for staff: A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Mark to have WELCA pay a \$100 bonus to Pastor and \$50 bonuses to Trudy, Monna and Beth. Mutual Ministry will pay the additional \$50 bonuses to Jim Kreger, Shirley and Lisa.

New Business:

A. Update the St Peter website to reflect 2023 council members pictures and bios. All council members will be installed on Saturday, December 17, 2022.

B. Update on November 28-29-30 church cleanup: Much was accomplished on those three days with many volunteers from outside St. Peter. There is still more to be done, especially in the Lau Hall area. We will try to have another series of workdays in January.

Jim will look into the cost and availability of a dumpster as FEMA will no longer be picking up debris.

- C. Structural Engineer report from Progressive: even though there is much damage from wind and water, there is still much integrity especially in the sanctuary building. None of the pilings were damaged and the main frame is intact and undamaged. The walls and roofline are plumb and straight. It is too soon to make any decisions on what will happen to the two buildings.
- D. Update on Servpro's cleanup: A bill for \$14,000. has been submitted for the cleanup provided by Servpro. We will ask for a more detailed invoice on what was done and how long it took to complete before paying this bill.
- E. On Saturday, December 17, 2022 worship will include synod representatives with a congregation meeting afterward at Peace Lutheran Church. A lunch will follow.
- F. Giving statements for 2022 need to be mailed by January 16, 2023. These must be signed by the treasurer. Guidelines have been previously set at \$250. and above.

G. Pastor's Report: staff continues to work remotely. Lisa Miller is continuing to work on sound problem and is meeting with Pro Audio this week. Pastor continues to provide pastoral care for members and friends who are displaced and grieving. She will continue to give constant contact updates.

She has also assisted with finding temporary residences for some of our members.

Pastor will be taking vacation January 17-26, 2023. LDR will be sending a disaster response chaplain (ordained) to cover, provide pastoral care, and lead worship while she is gone.

A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Mark to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed.

We adjourned at 7:37 p.m.

Update From Council President

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Teresa of Ávila, Interior Castle once said that ". . . it is presumptuous in me to wish to choose my path, because I cannot tell which path is best for me. I must leave it to the Lord, Who knows me, to lead me by the path which is best for me, so that in all things His will may be done."

I would like to thank you for your support of the council as we slowly move forward in our recovery from Hurricane Ian. As you know this is a daunting task and will take time. We appreciate your patience as we navigate the insurance and repair/rebuild process. This is a herculean task and will not be a quick. However, I wanted to take some time and update you on what has been accomplished since the new council was installed on December 17th.

- Congregational meeting was held with the Bishop Suarez on December 17th.
- A preliminary settlement estimate from Progressive flood policy of \$500,000 (policy maximum) building and \$140,000 contents was received. Final approval from the insurance company is pending.
- A preliminary settlement offer was received from Citizens Property Insurance of \$173,379. 61 after depreciation which is the wind policy that was in place.
- Council has contacted and consulted with an independent adjustor. No decisions have been made regarding hiring of said consultant.
- Holiday Demolition and Debris Removal has been hired for the debris removal and demolition of interior surfaces of Lua Hall, removal of flooring and compromised drywall in sanctuary building and the removal and disposal of all debris on property and under building. Work to begin approximately the week of 1/30. This is a local Ft. Myers Beach company.
- Preliminary contact has been made with the City of Fort Myers Beach regarding building/rebuild requirements.
- A zoom meeting is scheduled for February 1st with Pastor Khader,
 Pastor Sharon and Jason Kurtz to discuss recovery for St. Peter and outline plan for congregational discernment process.
- Council has begun research for reinstallation of electrical service for the sanctuary building.
- Sunday worship service was held on property January 29th in the parking lot.
