ST PETER EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING

Thursday, March 16, 2023

Members Present: Jason Kurtz, Arlene Burm, Jim Look, Jana Clevenger, Lynn Larson, PastorSharon Taylor (facetime)

- President Jason called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.
- Opening devotion and prayer by Pastor Sharon
- Motion made by Jim and seconded by Lynn to approve the agenda for the meeting. Motion passed.
- Motion made by Jana and seconded by Lynn to approve the Feb. 16th secretary's report. Motion passed.
- Since we just received the treasurer's report shortly before the meeting it was decided to table the motion to accept it until April when we have had more time to study it.
- Jana agreed to take the position of interim treasurer of the church council.
- Worship and Music Report: It was decided to continue the Sunday worship services in the St. Peter parking lot at 8:30 a.m. until the end of April. We will look into possibly videotaping or recording these services.

Old Business:

- A. Update on Keys Claims they will be coming to St. Peter on Tuesday, March 21 to evaluate wind damage on the sanctuary.
- B. Peace Lutheran Church signage the sign has been made but will need to be discussed with Peace on where we can place it. Pastor Sharon will discuss it with the pastor at Peace.

- C. Electrical All Phase Electric has been contacted but is too busy with work right now to look into it. We will contact other companies such as Semmer Electric to try to get an estimate.
- D. Construction update Owen-Ames-Kimball was contacted and visited our site with an architect for about 2 hours. They will put together a proposal within the next 2-3 weeks.

New Business:

- A. Roof Aspen Roofing gave us an estimate of \$105,000. For both the sanctuary and Lau Hall. It was decided to try and get another quote before any decision is made. The company must be registered with Fort Myers Beach in order to do the work.
- B. Lockbox Since various companies will need access to our building, Jason will get a lockbox to install on the sanctuary to provide keys for the sanctuary and porta-potty
- C. Annual Meeting March 25th following the church service at Peace followed by lunch and discernment meeting with representative from the synod.
- D. Jana made a motion and seconded by Lynn to give a \$500.00 check to Peace Lutheran for the use of their facility for our services. Motion passed. The last payment was in November of 2022 and another quarterly payment will be considered in June.
- The next church council meeting will be on April 20th at 5:30 p.m. at the home of Arlene Burm,
- We closed with The Lord's Prayer.
- Motion was made by Jana and seconded by Jim to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed.
- Meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.

From Lutheran Services

You may not know that we are currently needing more foster care families here in Lee County.

With all that our county has been through between Covid and Hurricane Ian, we've lost foster care families and have gained more children who need safe and caring homes.

Our staff works diligently to do all that we can, but often children are still waiting into the night for placement, being bounced around more than any child would ever deserve. We are asking our area churches to consider helping us by getting the word out: **We need foster care families!**

Each month in Fort Myers, children enter the foster care system because they were victims of serious abuse and neglect in their own homes. They often come into care with nothing but the clothes on their backs. Children in foster care are not someone else's children, they are our community's children.

You may have large networks through your career, family, hobbies, or social groups. Consider taking the lead for foster kids by sharing this information within your network to encourage people you know to become foster parents.
