## OUR MISSION

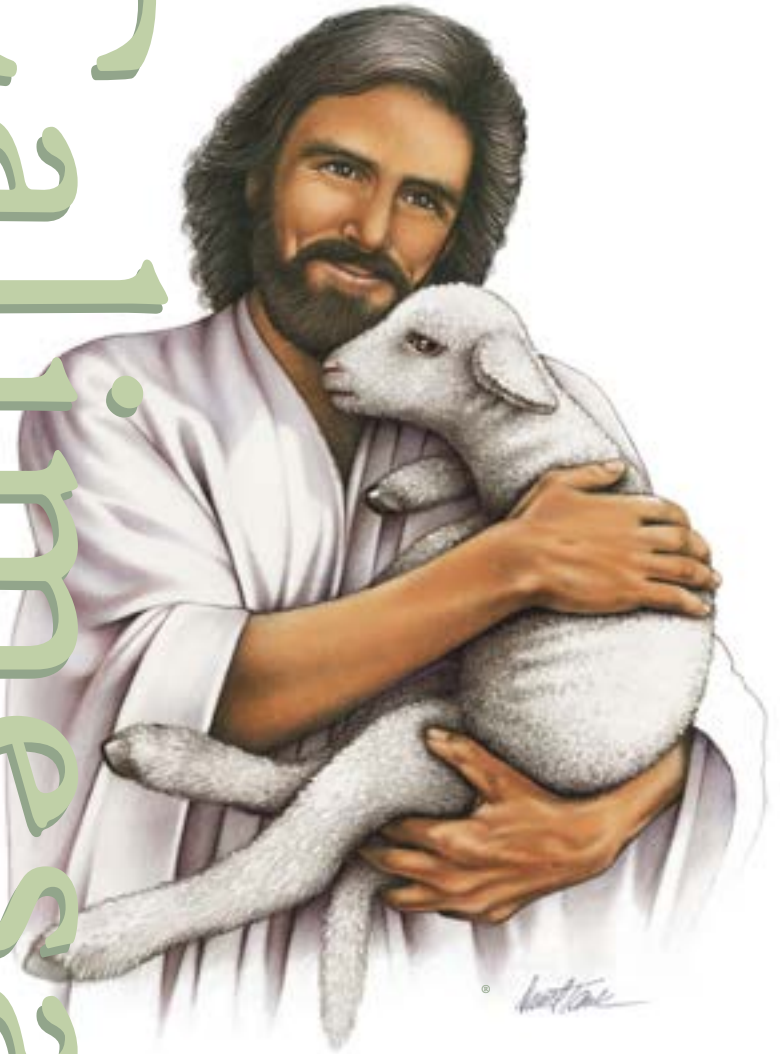
