

Acts of Jesus 37 notes

Acts 17:24-28 – “made from one man”

Paul was definitely not evolutionist – neither were any of the writers or speakers in the Bible.

--The Bible in no way supports an ancient earth much less that we evolved over millions of years from primordial goo.

Let's answer the question: Does the Bible actually say that God created in 6 twenty-four-hour consecutive Days?

1. All 7 days of creation are described by Moses as having one evening and one morning.

--Nowhere else in all of Scripture does God go out of His way like this to demonstrate that these were 24-hour days.

2. The Hebrew word for “day” is “Yom” and it is used in two ways in the Old Testament: One to describe a 24-hour day and the other to describe an indefinite amount of time.

--The determining factor in the two usages is whether or not “yom” is paired with a number.

--When it is used in conjunction with a number like “3 days” or “1st, 2nd, 3rd” as in the case of Genesis 1, it refers to a 24-hour day **without exception.**

3. Some might say, “24-hour days, but millions of years in between” – let's address that:

--In **Genesis 1:27**, it says that Adam and Eve were created on the 6th day.

--Therefore, they lived through at least part of the 6th and all the 7th day and yet Adam only lives to be 930 years old.

--The argument that there could have been millions of years in between each of those days falls apart with a simple question—why isn't Adam millions of years old?

4. The fourth commandment in **Ex. 20:9-11** states plainly that the Jews were to work six, 24-hour days and rest on the seventh, 24-hour day because God created all there is in the exact same time period.

All that to say, you can believe whatever you want that is your business, but you cannot say that the Bible teaches anything other than a 6, 24-hour, consecutive day creation.

Not only does the grammar of the Bible not allow for billions of years, it also regularly affirms the opposite:

--We have Paul in Acts who essentially affirms the 6-day creation in Genesis—you may say, “well, Paul just wasn't informed”. So, you are?

--He clearly states his position here.

We may say, “Well, the theory of evolution didn't come into being until the first half of the 19th century.”

--So, what we're saying is that we know more than Paul now?

--In addition, we know more than Luke a writer of the N.T.?

--In addition, we know more than the Holy Spirit who inspired the writing

of this text?

We know more than these?

Mark 10:5-9; John 5:46-47; Romans 1:20; Romans 10:17-18; Psalm 19:1-4

This is what we know from evolution:

“Through Unknown chemicals in the primordial past, and Unknown processes which no longer exist, these, nonetheless, produced Unknown life forms which are not to be found, but could, through Unknown reproduction methods spawn new life in an Unknown atmospheric composition in an Unknown oceanic soup at an Unknown time and place.”

Is this the way life on earth began?

--It is the only teaching allowed in public schools on the origin of life

How important is this issue? It is as important as the question: “Is there a God?”, “Is there morality?”

--If Creation is true = all answer to the Creator and His rules

--If Evolution is true= We are biological accidents who emerged by chance, and, therefore, right and wrong, laws, morals are all relative

--If evolution is true, humans are just animals and aborting unwanted cats is no different than aborting unwanted children.

--If evolution is true, there is no moral distinction between killing a human or killing a housefly.

--If evolution is true, the best thing for the survival of our species is for those with deficiencies to hurry up and die.

Fruits: Hitler and the third Reich—Hitler used Evolutionary ideas to promote the separation of and eventual annihilation of Jews, gypsies, and any other “less evolved”. He also practiced euthanasia on the physically and mentally handicapped claiming that **nature had selected against their genes and that they needed to be removed from the gene pool.**

--In the evolutionary thinking of the Third Reich, the Aryan race had not only the right but the obligation to exterminate all other races for the best survival of the species.

--After all, they were carrying evolution to its natural conclusions.

I have a question for Evolutionists—why don't they believe and follow their own stuff?

--For an Evolutionist to be consistent with his beliefs, he should make it his personal goal to shut down all hospitals, stop all medications, and allow the weak to simply die.

--Prolonging life medically of the genetically less endowed works against survival of the fittest = a basic tenant of evolution.

--The battle against the extinction of any species should immediately cease since *by destroying other species we prove* we are the highest evolved.
